

#### THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Wisdom 1:13-15,2:23-34
Reading II: 2 Corinthians 8: 7,9,13-15
Gospel: Mark 5:21-43

Touching is one of our basic human senses. We touch others physically by putting our arms around their shoulders or hugging them. Others touch us by the look in their eyes, by the words that they speak, by the acts of charity that they do for us. Touching is a beautiful means of communication. By our touch we can communicate comfort and support; love and affection. In the Gospel today, the word "touch" or its equivalent is used six times. It was through touch that the life of Jesus was communicated to the woman and she was healed. Jesus took the child by the hand, touched her, and she was restored to life.

"Just as the body without a spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead." (James 2: 26)

St. James in the 1st century counseled Christians that faith and <u>works</u> were necessary for salvation. A modern day version of the St. James letters, the Cursillo movement, emphasizes piety, study, and <u>works</u>.

Having recently joined the St. Vincent de Paul Society, I have witnessed men and women of our parish put their faith to action to help those less favored in our neighborhoods. These "clients" are in need of rent money, a bed to sleep in, food, money to keep the utilities working. Practical advice, and other forms of support.

As a new member, I have been impressed by how serious, varied, and complex the problems are; how emergent they are; and how appreciative the clients are with anything we have to support them. There are those who are clearly impoverished, and there are also many more just sitting on the fence, one lost pay check, one illness, one accident, and they are in serious trouble.

"Vincentians" do not have special degrees; they learn by experience to engage all the resources in the community to help their clients. We have access to food, furniture, employment resources, etc., to help people get started again. We are problem solvers, and are very conscious of how we are stewards of your donations. The poor have problems similar to ours, but they are much more difficult to solve; we bring community resources to help get them through.

Beginning this August the diocesan wide SVDP group is embarking on a new program—Coming Together to Get Ahead (STGA). From our experience with people in need we are recruiting clients who have initiative and want to learn how to climb out of poverty. This program should complement what we already do for clients one interaction at a time. The St. Thomas Vincentians are recruiting people willing to be mentors for individuals over a several month period. We thank all of you for your donations; and we are always looking for more good men and women to add "works" to their Christian faith. For just a few hours per week, the rewards are great, and you get the opportunity to work together with a wonderful group of fellow parishioners. We all have time limitations in our daily schedules. The St. Vincent de Paul group would be happy to accommodate your schedule.


