

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Amos 7:12-15
Reading II: Ephesians 1: 3-14
Gospel: Mark 6: 7-13

Most of us have been sent on an errand. A mother sends her son to the store to buy some groceries. A teacher sends a child home with a message. Persons doing errands are sent by someone; they do not go in their own name. The one sent carries a message or does a definite thing. It is not the message of the carrier, but the message of the sender that must be delivered. In the Gospel today, Jesus sends out his twelve on mission. They are to bring the good news of Jesus to others. Jesus instructs them what to say and do, and he gives them the necessary authority to speak in his name. He instructs them to travel light. All they need is the message. Their creaturely needs will be cared for by the hospitality of those who receive the message. He sends them in pairs for mutual support and to "sacramentalize" the love which they are preaching. This is the mission to which we all are called.


