

#### SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

Reading I: Acts of the Apostles 2:42-47
Reading II: 1 Peter 1:3-9
Gospel: John 20:19-31

On this second Sunday of Eastertime, as the newly baptized gather with the faithful to celebrate the Eucharist, the Gospel provides a mirror to remind us of the mystery of our assembly. At the disciples' gathering on the first day of the week, the risen Christ appears, breathing the Spirit on them and sending them forth. This is what happens each Sunday. Christ, risen from the dead, is among us and says to us, "Blessed are you who have not seen and have believed." Although we do not see Jesus as did the apostles, we do see Christ in the ongoing sign of his presence, his body the Church. This community of Christians is called to remain faithful to the teaching of the apostles who are witnesses to the resurrection, to the common life, evidenced by sharing of goods and made possible by the breaking of the bread, and to perseverance in prayer.
