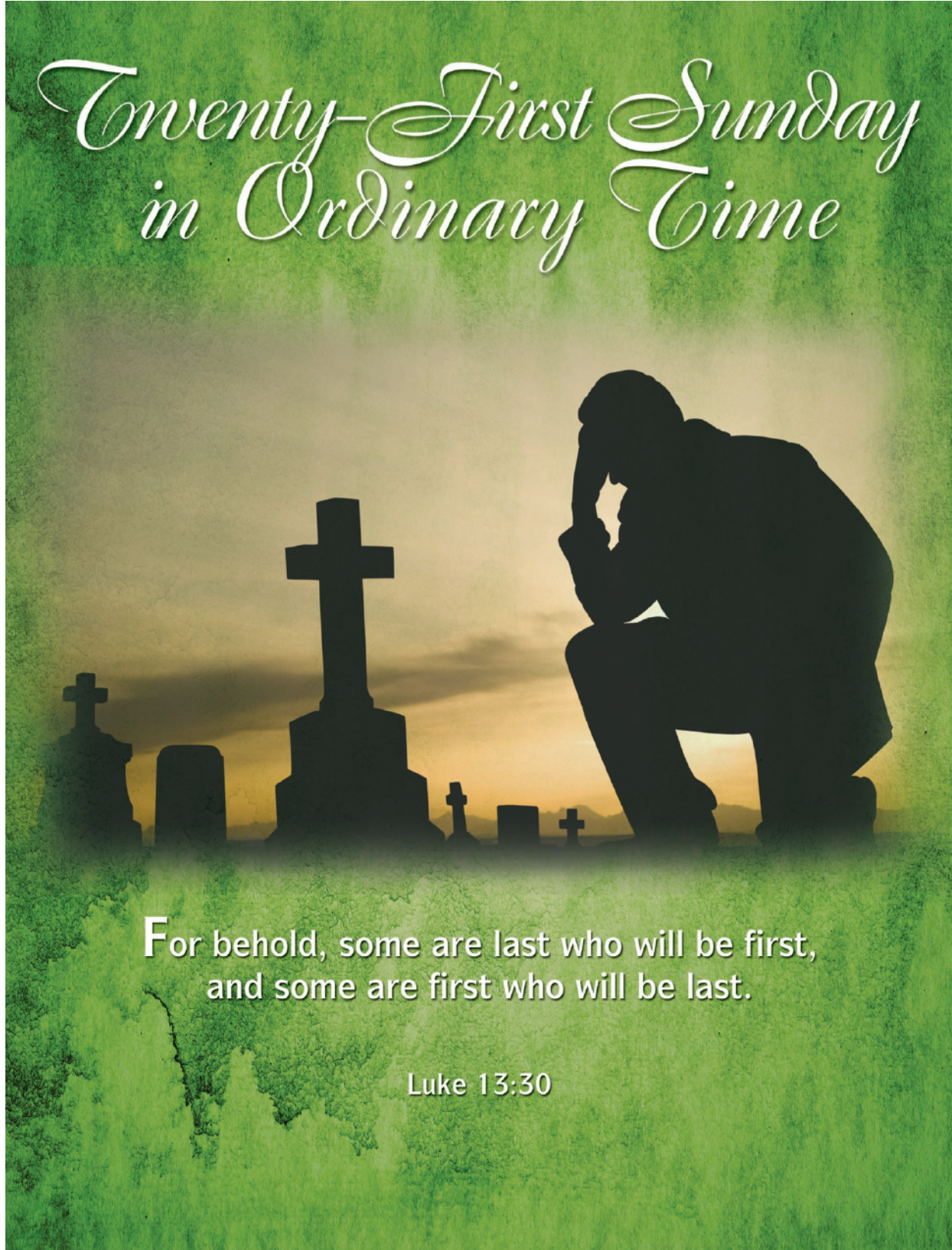

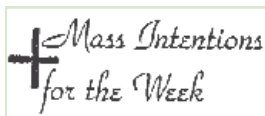
For behold, some are last who will be first,

Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah	66:18-21
Hebrews	12: 5-7, 11-13
Luke	13:22-30

The good news, as proclaimed by the prophet Isaiah, is that God intends to gather together all the people of the earth. Just as God has saved the Israelites, God will now be the God of all nations. All the peoples of the earth will come to know and see the glory of God. Even though the promise of salvation was offered to all, there were some who rejected it and who in consequence are rejected from the feast of the kingdom of God. In response to a question of whether there would be a lot of people saved, Jesus tells the story of the person who desired to get into the master's house, claiming to know the master, to have even eaten with him and to have heard him teach in the streets. The master of the house would not let him in, denying that he ever knew him. Jesus then raised a caution to those who were gathered. No one receives the kingdom because of ancestry. Rather, one must hear the word of God and live it in one's life in order to gain access to the feast of the kingdom. To do this is to come in through the narrow door. Those who fail to hear the word of the Lord and to respond to it will be turned away from the feast.
