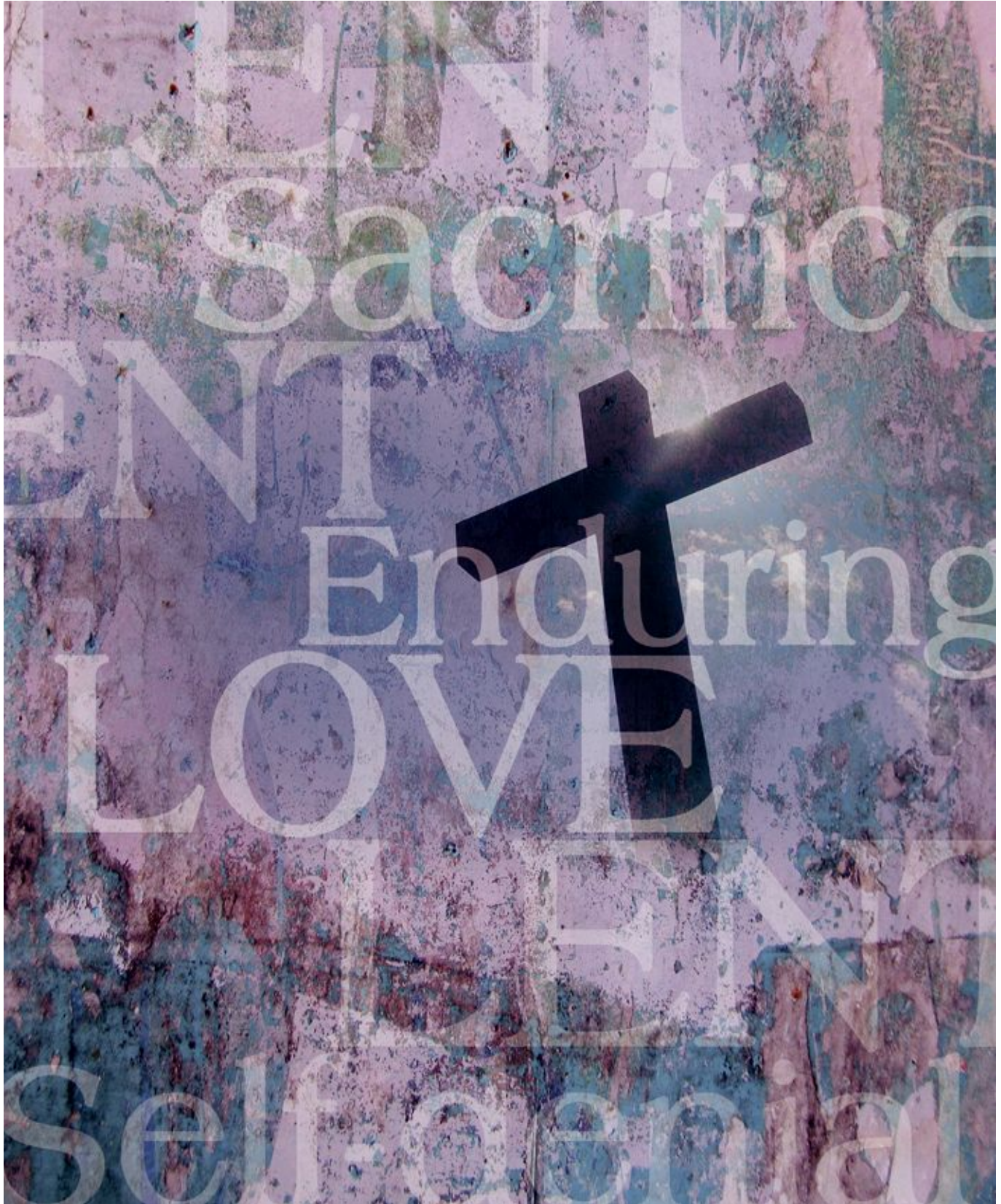




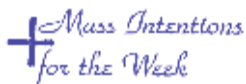

Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Reading I	Isaiah	6:1-2a,3-8
Reading II	1 Corinthians	15:1-11
Gospel	Luke	5:1-11

Isaiah is the recipient of a terrifying vision. He sees the Lord God. Yet, he is a sinner, and knows himself to be a sinner. Terror turns to invitation when his sin is removed by the Lord and Isaiah offers to be sent out as God's own prophet. While Simon Peter is not the recipient of a terrifying vision, he is nonetheless amazed at the miraculous catch of fish and the power of Jesus. Peter probably felt he was a mighty competent fisherman, and yet it is Jesus, the carpenter-preacher, who shows him where all the fish are that day. He knows himself to be imperfect. Jesus invites him to become more than he is. "Do not be afraid." In both readings an encounter with Jesus brings about self-knowledge. Prayer provides us with the same possibility.

My dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we enter into this Lenten season, the Church once again invites us to use this opportunity to share more fully in the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ. It is essential that we cultivate a deeper sense of prayer, fasting and almsgiving to better offer our lives to Our Lord.

As we make our way through these forty days of Lent, the Most Holy Triduum and to that glorious day of the Lord's Resurrection, I pray that all of us will be ever more attentive to our spiritual devotions and especially to the Word of God. May the guidance of the Holy Spirit assist us in our Lenten journey.

REGULATIONS FOR LENT & HOLY WEEK

1. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. All are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.
2. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, February 13, 2013 and all the Fridays of Lent.
3. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, February 13, 2013 and Good Friday, March 29, 2013.
4. On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
5. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.
