

The occasion of a wedding feast becomes the scene for Jesus' first sign of his glory. A miraculous transformation of water into wine gives us a hint that Jesus uses the very ordinary to show forth the kingdom of God. People are having a good time. They run out of wine. There is a bit of a panic. Jesus' mother turns to Jesus to help out the situation. It is a moment in the beginning of Jesus' ministry to make the connection between the promise of the covenant of God in the Old Testament and the fulfillment of that promise in the person of Jesus. It was not yet obvious, of course, but it was an important moment to see the movement of God's plan. A wedding is the perfect occasion to show the God's covenantal relationship. God is always faithful. Jesus shows God's fidelity of compassion throughout his ministry which begins with this miracle. Although the people around Jesus did not always get what Jesus was about or doing, they did become more inquisitive about who He was. They never really get it until after the Resurrection. Perhaps we can identify with the disciples who try to get it, but struggle with understanding Jesus' mission.
