

#### **ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Reading I: Ezekiel 17:22-24
Reading II: 2 Corinthians 5: 6-10
Gospel: Mark 4:26-34

Hope emerges as a theme from the readings today. But our hope is about lasting things. As Christians, it is about the coming of the reign of God. That is our ultimate hope. The images used are those of planting and harvesting. The hope we have is perhaps like that of a planter of seeds who does his best to assure the fruitful harvest. The mystery of growth, the mystery or gift of faith, is the link between seed and harvest. Forces in society and sometimes even elements within us challenge our hope. As followers of Christ, we have heard the word—the mustard seed of faith. We have our assurance that throughout the growing season and its difficulties, we are cared for by God, the planter, the gardener.




