Revised Common Lectionary

Second Sunday of Lent

Reading I: Genesis	12:1-4a
Reading II: 2 Timothy	1:8b-10
Gospel: Matthew	17:1-9

Our Gospel today relates a rather extraordinary occurrence: the transfiguration of Jesus. This transfiguration is a change in Jesus' appearance that allows the apostles to experience Jesus as he truly was—honest, vulnerable, in his glory. More importantly, however, the apostles experience a particular call from God. The message of the voice from the cloud ends with an active command: Listen to Jesus. The invitation is to trust the way of life of Jesus, to risk following Jesus. The transfiguration of Jesus is about our call to a blessed future. When we can trust God's call to follow Jesus, we can let go of all that we hold onto for security (such as prestige, honors, and money) and begin to see the various transfigurations happening all around us whenever women and men embrace honest, vulnerable and authentic lives patterned on the Gospel way of life.

My dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we enter into this Lenten season, the Church once again invites us to use this opportunity to share more fully in the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ. It is essential that we cultivate a deeper sense of prayer, fasting and almsgiving to better offer our lives to Our Lord.

As we make our way through these forty days of Lent, the Most Holy Triduum and to that glorious day of the Lord's Resurrection, I pray that all of us will be ever more attentive to our spiritual devotions and especially to the Word of God. May the the Holy Spirit assist us in our Lenten journey.

REGULATIONS FOR LENT & HOLY WEEK

1. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. All are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.
2. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2014, and all the Fridays of Lent.
3. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2014 and Good Friday, April 18, 2014.
4. On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
5. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.
