

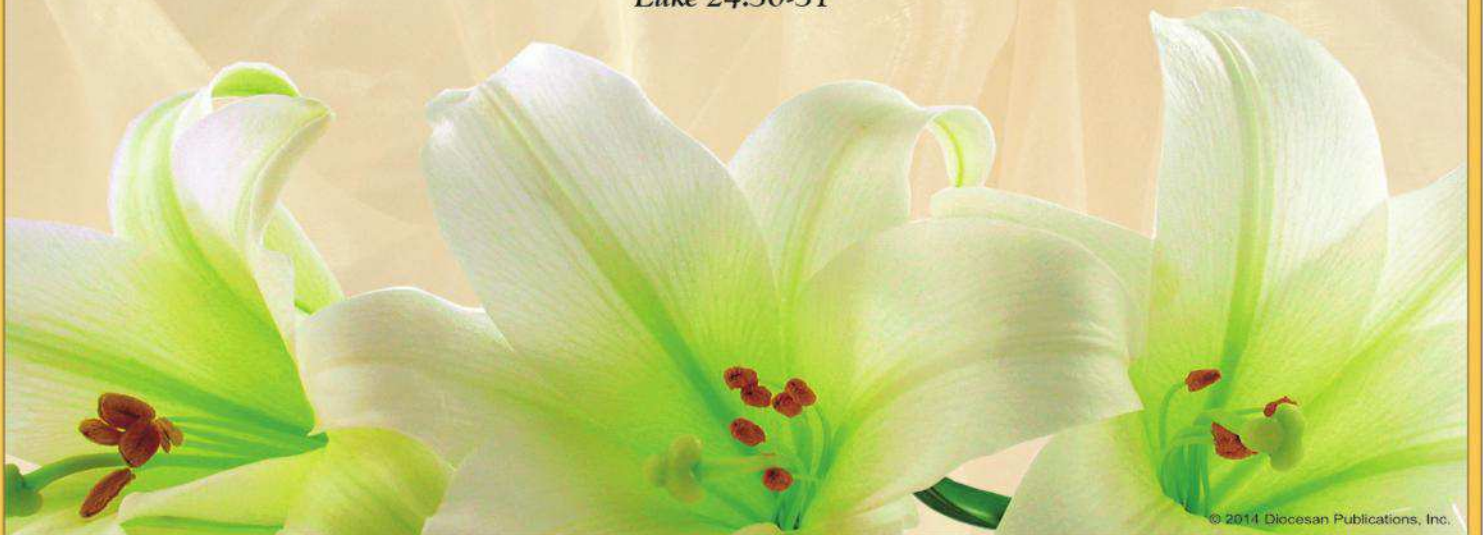

While He was with them at table, He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized Him, but He vanished from their sight.

Luke 24:30-31



THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

Reading I: Acts of the Apostles 2:14,22-33
Reading II: 1 Peter 1:17-21
Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

Today's Gospel recounts how the two disciples on the road to Emmaus had come to know Christ in the breaking of the bread. When Jesus sat down with them to eat, the stranger took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to the disciples. These familiar actions unmistakably brought to mind the Eucharist. Upon recognition Jesus vanished, emphasizing that no longer would he be visible in this glorified body, but in the sacraments. Christ is encountered through the meal and in the Scriptures. Thus the age-old pattern in Christian worship of word and sacrament is illustrated here as the means by which the risen Christ is made known to us. At first Jesus is a stranger to the two disciples; they don't recognize him. Their awareness of who he is comes later. In what ways have you grown to gradually recognize the presence of Christ in people or events in your life?

Our gospel reading today begins: "On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews..."
