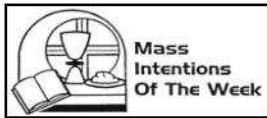

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Reading I: Acts of the Apostles 8: 5-8,14-17
Reading II: 1 Peter 3:15-18
Gospel: John 14:15-21

Today's readings, anticipating Pentecost, focus on the gift of the Spirit. The Spirit is called "another" mediator because Jesus is the first, and through the Spirit Jesus will come back as promised and remain. His departure thus results not in absence, although the world thinks Jesus has disappeared, but rather in continued presence through the Spirit. Our pledge of triumph, the Spirit among us, gives us basis for hope. Although he was put to death, Christ lives in the Spirit. Difficulties and persecution, then, pose no threat since this is the way we share in Christ's victory. Before his ascension, Jesus announced to the apostles that they would receive the Holy Spirit and be his witnesses to Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth.
