

I have been a member of three parishes here in Peoria over sixty years and, like most Catholics, have become familiar with other parishes through travel. With time you realize that even though we are catholic in our liturgy, each parish has its own unique ambience and customs. When I came to St. Thomas I had to get used to the fact that the St. Vincent de Paul collection occurred after Mass rather than during the offertory on the first Sunday of the month. There is the announcement after communion alerting you that the ushers will be balancing those little brown boxes with the green felt linings along with the bulletins as you move toward the gathering space. If you pay close attention you'll notice that some men instinctively check for their wallets and women glance at their purses. This action is, for me, simultaneous with the self query; "did I remember extra money"? Occasionally I still have to prevail on family or friends for a small term loan before I reach the door but I have gotten better about remembering before Church.

Creatures of habit, over time, this becomes a reflexive process move us from church to parking lot to car and then "home James and don't spare the horses". We know the money somehow gets from those boxes to the poor in the area, but for most of us, the how of it, is more mystery than knowledge.

As the money is counted, with all the \$20s, \$10s, \$5s, and \$1s, plus the coins from the small children, a new reality takes shape. The money is more than just money. It is individual acts of kindness, dictated by circumstances, and molded into communal generosity. SVdP members visiting those in need, listening to individual tragedies small and large, hearing prayerful hopes and needs, and turning those individuals gifts into the living presence of Christ.
