

THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Proverbs 31:10-13,19-29, 30-31

Reading II: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6 Gospel: Matthew 25:14-30

How do we think about the meaning of salvation? What relationship do we see between our lives now and the final judgment? To whom does life ultimately belong? The answer in the parable is clear: all that we have is a gift given to us. Life comes from God and belongs to God. To live solely for oneself is to live an illusion. When we are aware that our lives are part of a bigger reality than ourselves, we can be free to live with a new creativity, seeing our lives as a gift received and a gift given. Today's Gospel attacks the notion of faith as a security system for heaven. Like the action of the men in the Gospel who are unafraid to invest their silver piece, faith for us is a risk, a letting go, a willingness to walk. Salvation is not "saving one's soul" as much as it is generously expanding and donating it.






