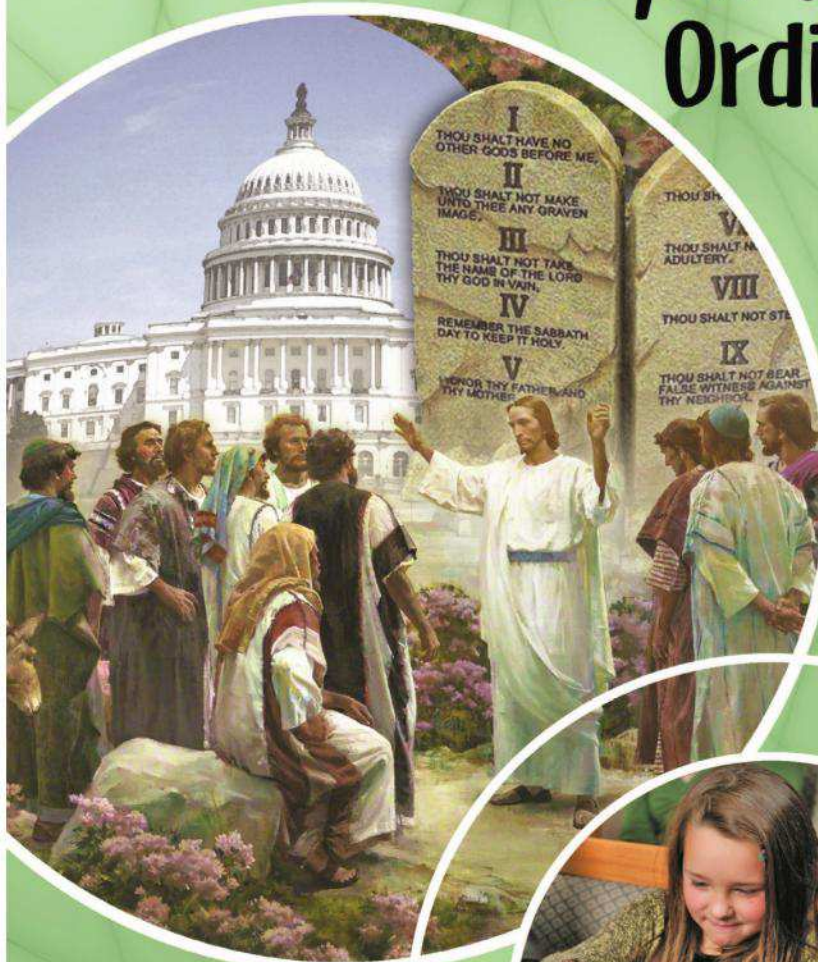

THE TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Isaiah 45: 1,4-6
Reading II: 1 Thessalonians 1: 1-5b
Gospel: Matthew 22: 15-21

Jesus' statement in this week's Gospel has been quoted out of context numerous times. "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's, but give to God what is God's." The Herodian sympathizers supported the puppet ruler of Israel, Herod Antipas. They would have supported the tax because Herod's power was totally dependent on Rome. The Pharisees, however, being the most devout of all Jews, would have opposed the tax and Roman rule. If Jesus says payment is licit, he may be portrayed as a Roman sympathizer. If he says that payment to Rome is not to be obeyed, he is then a subversive. Jesus refuses to be trapped by the question. By answering as he does, he demonstrates the relative value of all commitments in comparison to the commitment to love God.

Singing Rooster Coffee Sale to Support to Haiti Mission Connection Projects in Bodarie, Haiti

Haiti Mission Connection seeks to help the people of the village of Bodarie by providing medical care at a year-round clinic staffed by a Haitian nurse, mobile clinics, household water purification systems, and assistance for the school of the Parish of St. Benoit (St. Benedict).

If just 50 St. Thomas households drink Haitian Coffee for one year, we raise enough to buy water purification systems for 100 homes, or support the nurse for a year. Each bag of coffee directly supports Haiti -- half through Singing Rooster & half for our work in Haiti. Unemployment in Haiti is 70%; its potential as a self-sustaining country rests, in part, with economic development and opening up markets for Haitian goods like coffee.
