Christmas itself is the most important of these days and, together with Easter, stands as the high point of our liturgical year. 

# St. Vincent de Paul Society Annual Report

The St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Thomas is comprised of thirty-six members. This includes thirty who see clients (friends) in their homes, six who work at the Food Pantry, a finance person to manage the bookkeeping and a manager to coordinate a complex scheduling arrangement.

We get calls from people in distress who cannot make rent payments, debts to Ameren, sewer and water, etc. They face evictions and utility turnoffs. They have payday loan debt, which is an awful burden. Growth in calls from the Diocesan phone line were up approximately 20% in 2019 over 2018. All visits are made by two people. They take about one hour each, and most Vincentians will see one new client or more per week. About 10% of the calls are turned down. Some are repeat callers who are not able to improve their lives. Some are so far in debt that we can't help them. Mental illness can be a complicating factor.

Our Food Pantry has been growing. We served 4800 in the recent fiscal year, for a growth rate of 20%. Our delivery from the Midwest Food Bank has increased. We now commonly get meats and dairy, which require refrigeration and demand a more rapid turnover.

We often see people who have the motivation to change their lives. We have a *Coming Together to Get Ahead* (CTGA) program. This is a 16 week series of meetings designed to help these friends make a bigger transition.

Sometimes, our assistance pulls them out of a deep hole. Sometimes, we don't see it likely that our visit will bring lasting change. Our responsibility, however, is to provide assistance to the person in front of us who is in need. We learn from the experience, the poor will always be with you.

In 2019 we experienced a new problem. We closed operations on two occasions during August and September due to a lack of funds and just had to wait until the next collection.




