During Lent

Beginning, Thursday, February 27, we will offer an **additional daily Mass**,
Monday—Friday at 5:30 p.m.

During Lent we will offer opportunities for **Confession**, Saturdays from 4:00
to 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

Also during Lent, we will celebrate **Stations of the Cross** on Fridays at 7:00
p.m., followed by **Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament**.

Regulations for Lent and the Easter Triduum

Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests,
religious and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of
voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of
charity and mercy.

Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash
Wednesday, February 26, 2020, and all the Fridays of Lent.

Everyone 18 years of age, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on
Ash Wednesday, February 26, 2020, and Good Friday, April 10, 2020.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good
Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals,
sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's
needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating
between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including
milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be
seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious
matter.

What Do I Do During Lent?

HOW ABOUT: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving?

- ✠ Spend less time on phone, TV, computer and other technology and
spend more time with family
- ✠ **PRAY** the Angelus once a day or three times a day
- ✠ **PRAY** the Prayer to St. Michael, for protection against the devil, and
the forces of evil
- ✠ **FAST** Go through the closets in your house and in your mind and get
rid of 40 things in 40 days—stuff, bad attitudes, harmful practices.
Then don't bring any of it back
- ✠ **ALMSGIVING** Lent asks us to focus more seriously on almsgiving,
charity to others. Donating money or goods, and perform other acts
of charity. Almsgiving is a witness to fraternal charity & a work of
justice, pleasing to God. (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, #2462).
We see several special collections throughout Lent, serving local
appeals in our parish, the Diocese, and the Universal Church.
- ✠ How can you offer your time, talent and treasure, in your prayer,
fasting and almsgiving to people and organization in need during
Lent and throughout the year?

St. Thomas Vincentians made over 240 home visits in 2019 to clients in need. Many of our clients are barely getting by each week. They are one incident away from needing help, with no family assistance available. We give our clients a brochure with Social Services with addresses and phone numbers. To those needing a job we give an updated list of job opportunities and workshops provided by Goodwill.

Examples of how our St. Vincent de Paul Society helped clients recently.

- ◇ Medicaid help to assist a 44 yrs. Old legally blind gentleman to get a personal home aide.
- ◇ Rent assistance to a 25 yr. old single mom hospitalized with a broken arm from a car accident.
- ◇ Ameren assistance to a 72 yr. old who was in the hospital and late with her payments.
- ◇ Linens, sheets, comforters to a 36 yr old mother of young children for her new unfurnished apartment. Her last apartment burned down in a fire. She was working extra hours to replace everything they had. SVdP members also delivered a donated stove and electric dryer.
