Lent is a blessed season of spiritual renewal. Even though we talk about sacrifice and self-denial during Lent, I think we should think of Lent as a great opportunity to recommit ourselves to the Lord. With this positive perspective, let us enter wholeheartedly into this penitential season.

We are encouraged to make time for the three traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Making time for prayer can be done by saying the Rosary, reading Scripture, or making an extra visit to church for quiet prayer. We have added evening weekday Masses at 5:30 pm. Please note the schedule, since there are a few evenings when we are not able to have the 5:30 pm Mass (e.g. because of Confirmation or Chrism Mass). Friday evenings include extra time for confessions and prayer at 6 pm and Stations at 7 pm.

Making time for fasting is done through required days of fast and abstinence from meat. Beyond these very minimal sacrifices, many people add their own voluntary penances, which is an excellent practice. Remember that the areas that may be the most challenging may also be the areas of greatest growth. Beyond giving up a specific food, consider giving up specific beverages or alcohol. Consider fasting from dependence on technology, especially for young people. Consider fasting from sleep by getting up early and making time for prayer. Examine your life and ask yourself what change you could make that would make a significant long-term improvement for you? Let that be part of your Lenten practice.

Making time for almsgiving is done through generosity, giving of your resources, your time, your energy, or your talents. Prayer and fasting can be personal or private commitments we make to God and ourselves. Almsgiving is important because it directs us outside ourselves to others. Lent is not just about what you give up, but also what you give to others.

During Lent

Beginning, Thursday, February 27 we will have an **additional daily Mass** Monday through Friday at 5:30 p.m.

During Lent we will have **Confessions** on Saturdays from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

Also during Lent **Stations of the Cross** will be celebrated on Fridays at 7:00 p.m. followed by **Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament** at 8:00 p.m.

Regulations for Lent and the Easter Triduum

Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.

Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent.

Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Good Friday, April 10, 2020.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.

HOW ABOUT: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving?

- ✠ Spend less time on phones, TV, computer and other technology and spend more time with family;
- ✠ **Pray** the Angelus once a day or three times a day;
- ✠ **Pray** the Prayer to St. Michael, for protection against the devil, the forces of evil.
- ✠ **Fast** Go through the closets in your house and in your mind and get rid of 40 things in 40 days—*stuff*, bad attitudes, harmful habits. Then don't bring any of it back.
- ✠ **Almsgiving** Lent asks us to focus more seriously on almsgiving, charity to others, giving money or goods, & performing other acts of charity. Almsgiving is a witness to fraternal charity & a work of justice, pleasing to God. (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #2462). We see several special collections throughout Lent, serving local appeals in our parish, the Diocese, and the Universal Church.
- ✠ How can you offer your time, talent and treasure, in your prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to people and organizations in need during Lent & throughout the year?

Many of our clients barely get by each week, one incident away from needing help, with no family assistance available. We give our clients Social Services information, addresses and phone numbers. To those who need a job we give an updated list of job opportunities and workshops provided by Goodwill.

Examples of how our St. Vincent de Paul Society helped clients recently.

- ◇ Medicaid help to assist a 44 yr. old legally blind gentleman to get a personal home aide.
- ◇ Rent assistance to a 25 yr. old single mom hospitalized with injuries from a car accident.
- ◇ Ameren assistance to a 72 yr. old woman in the hospital, late with her payments.
- ◇ Linens, sheets, comforters to a 36 yr old mother of young children for her new unfurnished apartment. Her last apartment burned down in a fire. She was working extra hours to replace everything they had. SVdP members also delivered a donated stove and electric dryer.

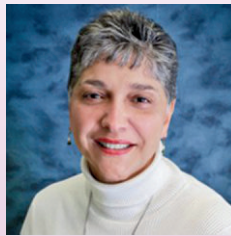

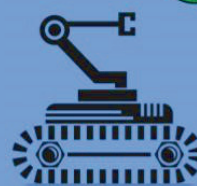

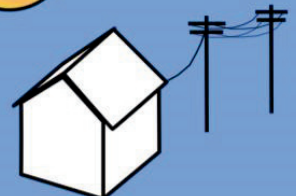
