

### **From Our Pastor**



We are learning more about how to stay safe while resuming more and more of our regular routines. One of those routines should be the regular participation in Sunday Masses. I was very much encouraged by the number of parishioners who have returned to Mass last weekend. Little by little, it seems that we are overcoming the fear that we all felt when we first learned about the virus.

Some parishioners have health conditions that require greater care. For these who are at risk, prudence urges us to take more precautions. No one is compelled to return to Mass if it is not safe to do so.

However, for those who can take reasonable precautions, I strongly urge you to get back into the habit of coming to worship in the Father's house on the Lord's Day. Come to be nourished by our common prayer as a community, and by receiving the Eucharist. There are more graces given when we choose to come to Mass voluntarily, especially when we are not required. Let us take advantage of these graces and offer up our prayers for the Church, and especially for our Parish and our School.

I would also like to draw your attention to the work being done in the Parish Office. We are undertaking some minor renovations to make this space more functional for our priests and our Parish staff. More information appears about the office in this bulletin.

I am personally very grateful for the service of the Franciscan Sisters of St. John the Baptist. They have been most helpful in caring for our Church and Chapel, especially through beautiful decorations. Most importantly, we all benefit from the prayerful witness of their religious life. They have recently agreed to serve as Sacristans, caring not only for the sacristy, but also setting up for each of our Masses and liturgies. # **Small Changes Coming** to the Parish Offices


The Parish Office was closed temporarily last week while work was done to remodel the space in the church basement.

Last year, we repurposed two rooms in the Church Basement to serve as our Parish Office. These were the former music room and the former Pre-K or art classroom. Last summer, we relocated student classrooms as much as possible, into the secure greas of the school, to increase school safety for our children. Keeping our children safe in a secure environment is one of our highest priorities.

The Parish Office has made use of these two rooms as they were previously configured. However, a few inexpensive modifications will make these areas more useful for our Parish staff.

There was no private area for the priests to meet with parishioners who might require privacy or confidentiality. We have walled off a small part of the Parish Hall to provide a more private location for a priests' office. There was also no way to pass between the two large rooms of the Parish Office. We have opened a door to allow staff to move from one room to the other. These very modest changes will make the Parish Office much more functional.

When the work is complete, we look forward to a Parish Office Open House for you to tour this area.
