Due to the Covid pandemic, we have replaced our preferred home visits with telephone interviews. A senior citizen called for assistance and repeatedly stated she doesn't like to ask for monetary assistance as there are others she feels are more in need. She requested help with a cell phone bill of \$95. Her

teenage grandson lives with her and she needs to keep in touch with him.

From our conversation, we learned she is a diabetic, and is also on dialysis three times a week. She has special dietary needs, and follows the guidance of her healthcare provider. She stated that her adult children usually help her, but because of the pandemic, their jobs and incomes have been negatively affected.

We shopped for cleaning supplies she had difficulty finding because of recent shortages. We also took her food from our Food Pantry, gave her a Kroger gift card, and paid her phone bill. Our client was very grateful for our concern and all we able to provid.

Please keep her in your prayers, and continue to support our Food Pantry, and our monthly collection for services that we provide.
