Due to the Covid pandemic our preferred contact of home visits has been replaced with telephone interviews. A senior citizen called for assistance and repeatedly stated she doesn't like to ask for monetary assistance as there are others she feels are more in need. She requested help with a cell phone bill of \$95. Her teenage grandson lives with her and she needs to

keep in touch with him.

From our conversation, we learned she is a diabetic and is on dialysis three times a week. She has special dietary needs and is compliant with guidance from her healthcare provider. She stated her adult children usually help her, but due to the pandemic their jobs and incomes have been negatively affected.

We shopped for cleaning supplies that she had difficulty finding due to recent shortages. We also took her food from our pantry and gave her a Kroger gift card and paid the phone bill. Our client was very grateful for our concern and what we were able to provided.
