Recommended Reading from Msgr. Gray

Psycho-Cybernetics: Updated and Expanded by Maxwell Maltz

Dr. Maltz uses the term *Psycho-Cybernetics* to describe the way we were created with a brain that is engineered to help us be successful. However, we can also psych ourselves out to repeat negative behavior. The book addresses ways to overcome negative and false beliefs that can preoccupy our mind. Instead, we can develop positive goals and a sense of confidence that we can accomplish them. The mind helps us unconsciously accomplish the goals that we set for ourselves, so let the mind move us in a positive direction.

Dr. Maltz presents the fruits of his research in the way that our self-image controls our ability to achieve any goal, with examples of ways that a negative self-image sets us up to fail to achieve a goal.

I found the ideas in the book very intriguing. The approach is filled with lots of examples and practical suggestions to help ourselves focus and become the best version of ourselves that we can be.
