This Tuesday is the celebration of the Anniversary of the Dedication of St. Thomas Parish. On October 6, 2002, the new church was dedicated by Bishop Jenky. This anniversary is a special solemnity for us each year. Please join us for Mass on Tuesday either at 7 or 8 AM.

We are preparing a special event to celebrate the progress in the sanctuary of the church and the renovated Parish Offices. In mid-November we will have a progressive tour of the building.

This should be a fun evening for us to dive into the successes that we've enjoyed. We can celebrate the church and what we've accomplished. We can also work to improve our school. I look forward to welcoming our St. Thomas Parish and School families to join in this event. More to come!
