From Our Pastor



Our parish is a family. As we celebrated the anniversary of the dedication of St. Thomas Church last week, we are reminded about the blessings of our church building. But, the readings for the anniversary Mass remind us that we are united by more than the physical structure where we pray. We are bound together for a common purpose: to worship Jesus Christ as members of his Body.

One of the most important qualities of a family is the loving support we give to each other. Our parish supports our school and our school is a central part of the life of our parish. The generosity of our parishioners to our community is also well known through our food pantry and outreach to the poor.

In the past, I have asked for your support through your financial offerings to our weekly collection or to the Annual Diocesan Appeal. In the past, I have asked for your support for our school through tuition assistance, or your contributions to the liturgical improvements in the sanctuary.

This week, I ask for a different kind of support by volunteering your time. We have all been impacted in one way or another by the virus, and St. Thomas has had to adapt as so many of you have to the present circumstances. Many have returned to Sunday Mass, while some have prudently taken extra precautions to stay safe for the sake of your own health or the health of those you love and care for. For those who are ready to return and even volunteer, I ask for your time in these ways.

We have a portion of our servers, readers, and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion who have resumed their service. We will need some others to help fill in the gaps. We will need to train new ministers in a safe way, and insure they are prepared and qualified for these roles. If you are interested in volunteering, please step forward and we can make sure we have enough volunteers for our Masses.

We sometimes run short of volunteers for Comet Cash on the weekends, and for service in our food pantry which operates on Monday and Thursday mornings. If you can give your time, these are important roles of service needing volunteers.

We will have an evening Progressive Tour (not a Progressive Dinner) this year in November to escort small groups around the renovated Church and Parish Office spaces and celebrate our accomplishments.

October Respect for Life Month

Human beings are made in the very *image and likeness of God*. As is well recorded throughout the nearly twenty centuries of our religious history, Catholic believers have always opposed abortion and considered the act to be unjust and gravely sinful. 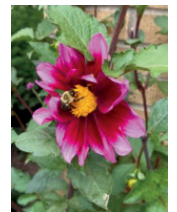
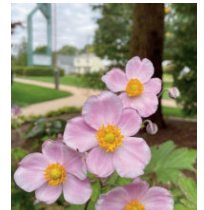
