Adult Education Presentation: Lessons Learned during weight loss

Tuesday, October 27, 7 pm in the St. Thomas Parish Hall

St. Thomas has offered presentations on a variety of topics in the past. This year, we will start with a more personal topic: Msgr. Gray will present on lessons learned during weight loss.

After losing 60 pounds since January, Msgr. Gray is happy to offer some observations about lessons learned along the way. Everyone is different and has their own experience of self-improvement in making a positive transformation. This presentation will share more personal reflections about this experience.

The lessons learned go beyond just calories in and calories burned, the fundamental basis for any body transformation. Mindset is an important part of this change, including finding motivation, building habits, dealing with hunger, and striving for consistency. This talk will present more than just physical development, including growing both mentally and spiritually at the same time.

Msgr. Gray's Book Recommendations

1984 by George Orwell

This classic is worth revisiting in our modern society. This dystopian novel depicts a fictional world under English totalitarianism in 1984 in which every thought, word, and action is surveilled by Big Brother as the representative of the socialist government.

This book is worth reading for the terms that have made their way into our lexicon today: *Big Brother*, *thoughtcrime*, *memory hole*, *doublethink*, and $2+2=5$.

George Orwell depicted a world of total government surveillance, but in our world today, we are familiar with *political correctness* on social media and on the internet. *Cancel culture*, *internet censorship*, and *shadow banning* are terms that might make their way into a modern version of this novel. This provocative book makes us think about our freedoms and the modern world in which we live.

 We are travelers on the road
 We are here to help each other
 Walk the mile and bear the load...

This may sound familiar as it is from a hymn we sing at St. Thomas.

St. Vincent de Paul had a vision of Christ, not as a teacher or healer, but as an Evangelizer to the Poor. Our goal is to help alleviate the problems that confront the poor in our area. Sometimes it is by financial assistance, other times by giving additional information or a referral.

Because of your generosity (in the first Sunday of the month collections) we have funds available to provide assistance to people who call Catholic Charities requesting help. They then refer the calls to the St. Vincent de Paul Society chapter in the Peoria parish nearest to the family's home. SVdP then determine the need and how we can be of assistance.
