

From Our Pastor



The work in the Sanctuary is more than 90% complete. We have a few more details that will be finished in the coming weeks.

Candles and candlesticks, in the same style as our Easter Candle stand, will be added around the altar and on the reredos on the back wall. The wood railings will be replaced by metal railings to match the existing handrails. The sanctuary furniture will be replaced with darker wood, which should cause the white marble to stand out even more. Some patching and touch up work will help finish off the rough edges.

An ambry will be added to the sanctuary wall to hold the Holy oils. As you know, each year, at the Chrism Mass the Bishop blesses the Oil of Catechumens, the Oil of the Sick, and the Sacred Chrism, used at Baptisms, Confirmations, and Anointings of the Sick. These oils are retained in the Sacristy, but they can be displayed in the Sanctuary. This will be a wonderful addition to our church.

We have received donations to pay for mosaic Stations of the Cross. I am grateful for these contributions and those that have already been received to fully pay for the cost of the work that has been done. Since it will take time for the Stations to be prepared, we hope to have them in the first months of next year, God willing, in time for Lent.

I look forward to a solemn blessing of the new fixtures. I hope to have this blessing on Christ the King, the Sunday before Thanksgiving, at 9 am Mass.

Each nomination should include the name of the person making the nomination, the person being nominated, and a short comment about the qualities that make the candidate a good nominee to the Parish Council.




