Advent

From Our Pastor



We continue our Advent pilgrimage to the Nativity of Our Lord at Christmas. Let this be a holy season for us to prepare our hearts to welcome the Birth of Jesus.

There are several adaptations we will have this year because of precautions due to Corona. We have been given permission to add an earlier Mass on Christmas Eve. Therefore, we will have Masses on Christmas Eve at 3 PM, as well as 5, 7, and 10 PM. Masses on Christmas Day will be at the normal times: 7, 9, and 11 AM. We have overflow seating in the narthex and in the Chapel to allow for distancing. We will also be able to add additional overflow seating in the Parish Hall downstairs where we will be able to use the projector screen to broadcast the Mass in the main church for any who attend there. Communion will be brought to those attending in each area.

We will not schedule a Parish penance service, since we do not want to encourage groups of people to gather if it is not necessary. Rather, we will add additional confession times. We will have expanded confession hours for the Fourth Sunday of Advent on both Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. We will hear confessions each weeknight before Christmas Eve (from December 21-23).

Daily Masses have been moved to the main church where the congregation is able to spread out more than in the daily Mass chapel. You are most welcome to join us for weekday Masses.

This Tuesday is a Holy Day of Obligation for the Immaculate Conception, though the obligation to attend Mass has been dispensed this year. For those who wish to attend, please note the special Mass times: There will not be a school Mass during this time of e-learning.

For those who have downloaded *My Parish App*, there are special resources for Advent you can use. If you haven't downloaded this app, you will find it in both the Apple and Google app stores.

The O Antiphons of Advent

There are seven short verses sung before the Magnificat during Evening Prayer of the Church on the seven days before the vigil of Christmas. They each begin with the exclamation O, each ends with a plea for the Messiah to come. As Christmas approaches the cry becomes more urgent.

The antiphons were composed in the seventh or eighth century when monks compiled texts from the Old Testament which looked forward to the coming of our salvation. They form a rich mosaic of scriptural images. These seven antiphons appear to be the originals, although from time to time other texts were used. They became very popular in the Middle Ages. While the monastic choirs sang the antiphons the great bells of the church were rung.

A curious feature of these antiphons is that the first letter of each invocation may be taken from the Latin to form an acrostic in reverse. So the first letters of Sapientia, Adonai, Radix, Clavis, Oriens, Rex, and Emmanuel, form the Latin words: ERO CRAS. This is the response of Christ Himself to the heartfelt prayer of His people: *Tomorrow I will be there.*

We pray the antiphons from December 17—December 23. The antiphons will be in next week's bulletin.
