St. Vincent de Paul Society Annual Report

The St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Thomas is comprised of thirty-six members. This includes thirty who see clients (friends) in their homes, six who work at the Food Pantry, a finance person to manage the bookkeeping, and a manager to coordinate a complex scheduling arrangement.

We get calls from people in distress who cannot pay rent, or their Ameren, sewer or water bills, etc. They face eviction and utility turnoffs. They have payday loan debt which is an awful burden. Two Vincentians work together on each case. We are currently visiting by phone rather than in the client's home because of Covid 19. We continue to deliver food in emergency situations. Each call takes about one hour, and most Vincentians will see one or more new clients per week. About 10% of the callers are turned down. Some are repeat callers who are not able to improve their lives. Some are so far in debt that we can't help them.

We made 211 calls and helped 525 people. These numbers are down from the prior year. This could be due both to the stimulus checks and the higher unemployment checks. Demand picked up significantly in September.

SVDP helps with the cost of running the St. Thomas Food Pantry which has been growing. We served 5111 people in the recent fiscal year, for a growth rate of 6%. We continue to pick up food from the Midwest Food Bank. We now commonly get meat, fruit and dairy which require refrigeration and demand a more rapid turnover.

We often see people with the motivation to change their lives. Our Coming Together to Get Ahead (CTGA) program is a 16 week series of meetings designed to help these friends make a bigger transition.

Sometimes, our assistance pulls them out of a deep hole. Sometimes, we don't see it likely that our visit will bring lasting change. Our responsibility, however, is to provide assistance to the person in need, in front of us. We learn from the experience that the poor will always be with us.
