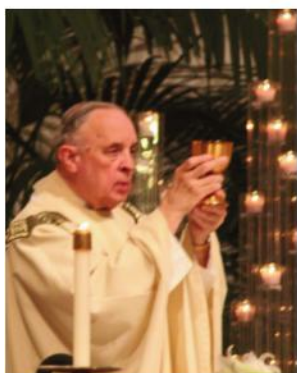

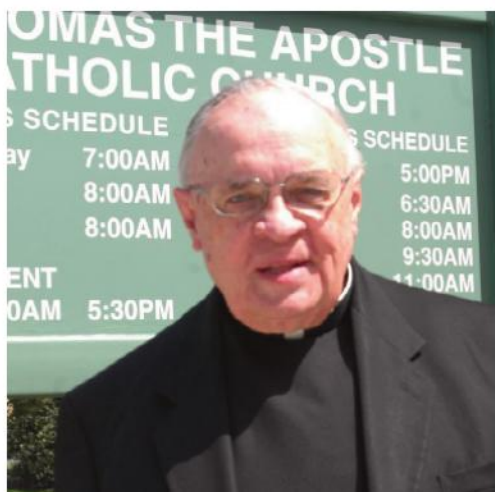

Last week we were able to honor Msgr. William Watson who was laid to rest in Odell. His funeral service can be seen on the Watson Thomas Funeral Home website. He was born in 1936 and died at the age of 85. He served as our second Pastor from 1981 until his retirement in 2015. We are grateful for the 34 years of faithful and generous service that he gave to St. Thomas the Apostle Parish!

We will take some time this week to organize a fitting tribute to Msgr. Watson and to plan a Memorial Mass for him here. Msgr. William Watson

In a 2015 interview with The Catholic Post, Msgr. Watson said he thought about being a priest from a young age. His parents went to daily Mass. "The church was almost as much a part of our life as our home was," he recalled, resulting in close contact with parish priests and the Springfield Dominican Sisters.

He was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Peoria on June 3, 1962, by Bishop John B. Franz at St. Mary's Cathedral in Peoria.

In 1981, Msgr. Watson received his first assignment as pastor. It would also be his last. He guided St. Thomas the Apostle Parish — one of the largest parishes in the diocese — until his move to senior status in 2015.

His 34 years at the Peoria Heights parish saw dramatic growth in its physical plant. He oversaw an addition to the south side of the school in 1995. The present church was built and dedicated in 2002 while preserving the original church. The former convent was renovated for parish offices and a new rectory was built, linked to the church by a skywalk.

Known for his compassion, gentle leadership, and Irish wit, Msgr. Watson found joy in the support of parishioners, his brother priests, and the offering of daily Mass, which he called "the center of my life."

Training sessions will be held in the church.

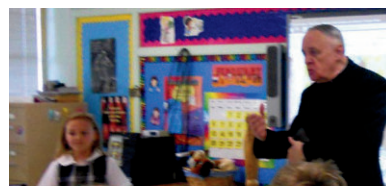

Packing groceries, registering clients, restocking shelves, repackaging food, helping clients with food selection and assisting clients to their vehicles, are activities students will perform with adult supervision.

An additional service opportunity is available one Thursday per month when we receive a truckload of food products from Midwest Food Bank. On these days, students help adult volunteers unload the truck, repack food, rotate stock and stock shelves.
