From Our Pastor

Today we celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord. With the Ascension, the public ministry of Jesus was brought to a close, while the mission of the Church was about to begin with the promised descent of the Holy Spirit. Jesus descended from Heaven at the Annunciation when the Word became flesh. Today, Jesus ascends back to Heaven, taking with him our human nature.

The Ascension is a foreshadowing of the promised resurrection that we will all share in at the end of time. We remain anchored in hope of the day when we can rejoice with God, body and soul in eternity.

We have other good news related to our return to normal after the pandemic. The Bishops of Illinois, with Cardinal Cupich, negotiated with the Governor the provision that allowed us to return to Mass with attendance of up to 25% of our church capacity. We have been fortunate to have a large main church, with additional seating in the narthex and chapel, and the capacity to broadcast Mass also to the parish hall. The Archdiocese of Chicago is about to raise the attendance limits up to 60% of capacity. This is a very hopeful sign and demonstrates the progress we are making.

For our lectors and extraordinary ministers, please note the refresher sessions we will have to review our procedures for reading and distributing Communion. As more and more of us return to regular Mass attendance, this is a good time to renew these important ministries.

Finally, please join us for the Msgr. Watson Memorial Mass on Tuesday, May 18, at 5:30 pm. We will remember the many years of service of our second Pastor. Everyone will be invited downstairs for refreshments after the Mass. It is good for us to pray for his eternal rest and to be thankful for his 34 years of faithful service to St. Thomas.


