## **From Our Pastor**

Happy Father's Day to all the fathers within the parish. Fr. Stark and I join with you as spiritual fathers for you at St. Thomas.

We had many different volunteers who helped with our playground construction day, but I offer a special thank-you in particular to the fathers who came out to do so much of the heavy lifting last Saturday.

Last weekend, I suggested in my homily that we all reflect on the past year to learn from the trials that we all had to endure during the pandemic. We have all learned to operate differently by finding new ways to do old tasks. We have had to work at being effective in work or school and strengthening our relationships with family and fellow parishioners. We have been forced to evaluate our priorities, hopefully rediscovering the things that are most important in our lives and separating them from the trivial.

Reestablishing our relationship with God and with one another as a parish is an important task for all of us as we emerge from the past year. Let this be a time of renewal, prizing our faith, the celebration of the sacraments, and the bonds of fellowship with fresh energy! I have two specific opportunities to recommend:

—we have five nursing homes in our parish boundaries and have not been able to visit with the Catholic residents for more than a year. Now that we have the opportunity to make pastoral visits, we look forward to seeing our elderly, and offering Communion once again. I have reached out to some of our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to help take Communion to the sick. This corporal work of mercy is service to Christ Who we help every time we visit one of the least of these (Mt 25:40). If you're interested in assisting the visits to the elderly or taking Communion to them, please step forward.

—we have also begun to offer funeral lunches again, with our Martha Group, to grieving families on the day of a funeral. Volunteers have been very helpful by either (1) dropping off a dish for the luncheon, or (2) by being present to help serve the lunch after the funeral Mass. If you're able to assist with either of these areas, please volunteer.



## The Playground Build


Many dedicated workers came out on a really hot day to help build a great play structure for our STS students. Check it out next to the back park-ing lot/playground!




