From Our Pastor

During these summer months, we have a celebration special to us at St. Thomas. On the celebration of our patron's feast day, Saturday, July 3rd, we will celebrate Mass to honor St. Thomas the Apostle at 8 AM. The day before, July 2, we have First Friday Adoration, from 8:30 AM to 8 PM. Please join us to adore the Eucharist and to celebrate our patron.

Let us give thanks for the freedoms and independence we enjoy in the United States, as we celebrate the Fourth of July next Sunday. May God bless our country!

There has been considerable discussion in the news about worthiness to receive the Eucharist. This might be a good time to review some basic aspects of our teaching on Holy Communion.

When we eat ordinary food, such as a donut, we do not ask ourselves whether we are worthy to consume this donut. We know the food we eat will be used to fuel our body as it is digested and incorporated into our cells. We might ask whether we should consume the calories, but we don't ask about our worthiness to eat the donut.

The Eucharist, however, is the Body of Christ. We are not receiving an inanimate source of nourishment. Communion is the living and real presence of Jesus, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, which we recognize by faith as truly present under the appearance of ordinary bread. This is no ordinary food, since we approach Our Lord Who is our Creator and the Savior of our souls. Rather than transforming the Host into our body, we are the ones transformed by Jesus to become members of **His** Body.

We say Communion, because through the Eucharist, we are in communion with Jesus and with the members of His body in the Church throughout the world. If we are not fully united in the communion of the Church, then receiving the Eucharist becomes a contradiction. This can occur if we are married outside the Church, or if we fall into grave sin that is mortal. We are always encouraged to ask for a blessing if we are not prepared to receive Communion at Mass. It is also best to go to confession when we need to be reconciled with Our Lord.

In future columns, I will talk about the importance of professing the faith in connection with receiving the Eucharist.

Parish Solemnity July 3

On this day we celebrate the feast of St. Thomas the Apostle, our Patron Saint for whom our church is named. In 1924, Bishop Joseph Schlarman designated the Mission of St. Thomas to serve Catholics in Peoria Heights, at the time part of the northern territory of St. Bernard Parish. On August 15, 1924, he purchased what had been well known as Herbstrith's café on the corner of Lake and Monroe streets for \$8,500. What had been a popular supper club was transformed: the sacristy was created from what was the bar; the dining room became a meeting room; and the dance hall was transformed into the church.

In 1937, Bishop Schlarman elevated St. Thomas from a Mission to a Parish. He appointed Father Bernard Rank to serve the new parish of 100 families. Then, in 1940, work began on a permanent church, dedicated by Bishop Schlarman on December 9. This church is now our Daily Mass Chapel.

In 1981, Msgr. (then Fr.) William Watson became our second pastor. He oversaw the 1995 addition to the school, and the construction of our current church, dedicated in 2002.

Most recently, Msgr. Gray has overseen the renovation of the church with the addition of more mosaics and the stenciling in the sanctuary, unifing the symbolism within our two worship spaces.

St. Thomas the Apostle appears in two mosaics ~ in the large mosaic in the narthex as *Doubting Thomas*, and as a carpenter in the far left mosaic in the sanctuary *reredos*.

St. Thomas also appears in a few specific passages of Scripture: when Jesus prepares to go to Jerusalem, Thomas says he will go to die with Him (Jn 11:5-16); at the Last Supper, Thomas asks a question and Jesus teaches him He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (Jn 14:1-7). Thomas is probably best known for his words of faith after the Resurrection, My Lord and My God (Jn 20:19-29).

After the Resurrection, Thomas was said to have evangelized Parthia and brought the Gospel as far as India. According to Tradition Thomas visited the Indo-Parthian King Gondophernes who put him in charge of building the royal palace, since Thomas had skills as a carpenter. Hence, Thomas is depicted with the carpenter's square. He was martyred at Madras, which explains the depiction of the spear (spear and square are in our mosaic).

He is the patron saint of India, architects, builders, and our Parish.






