#### From Our Pastor

Happy Fourth of July! It is good to appreciate all the gifts we have in the United States and the blessings that we have received. Beyond physical gifts, the blessings of freedom are among those we should cherish most. Even during times of political disagreement, our shared love for our country is a theme that can unite us. As Catholics, we pray for our country and ask God to continue to guide us and pour out His grace upon us and our civic leaders.

Last week, I mentioned the importance of being united to Jesus, and in communion with the Church, as we approach to receive Holy Communion. It is good to remember what unites us in *full communion* with the Catholic Church.

**Full Communion** with the Church includes three elements: we share a common faith, a common worship through the sacraments, and we recognize a common governing authority, especially through our Holy Father.

Common faith means we are united by the same fundamental beliefs that have been revealed by God. We express those beliefs every Sunday when we recite the Nicene Creed. In addition to the Creed, we also believe the infallible and unchangeable truths contained in the Word of God and taught by the Church. These include the dogmas about Jesus Christ, the Blessed Mother, the sacraments, the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, original sin, and the grave immorality of directly and voluntarily taking innocent human life.

**Common worship** means we are united by the common celebration of the seven sacraments. We worship God through the same sacraments as Catholics around the world, and we believe in the grace we receive through those sacraments.

**Common governance** means we are united by our obedience to our Holy Father, and to our bishops, who teach authentically in the name of the Church, as representatives of Christ.

We always have respect for our Christian brothers and sisters in other Christian religions, but we recognize we are not in full communion with them because we differ on one or more of those three elements: common faith, common sacraments, and common acceptance of the Holy Father's authority. We do not have inter-communion with them, meaning that we do not receive Communion in their churches and we do not admit their members to Communion at our Masses.

In future columns, I will talk in greater detail about sharing the same faith, as Catholics united by our common reception of Holy Communion.

This time, I suggest Mindset: The New Psychology of Success by Carol Dweck.

This book distinguishes between the growth mindset and the fixed mindset. The fixed mindset focuses on abilities we already have, while the growth mindset focuses on the skills and gifts we can develop by confronting challenges. When confronted by something new and difficult, the fixed mindset tends to become frustrated and sees the challenge as a cause for failure. The growth mindset looks at new challenges as opportunities for growth with the possibility of learning something new.

It is a fascinating read with applications to achieving our personal goals, finding success in sports, making accomplishments in business, developing positive relationships, and even becoming a more effective parent, teacher, or coach.

#### When you go the poor, you encounter Jesus



Did you know that through your prayers, kindness, and generous financial assistance to the St. Vincent de Paul Society, you recently helped a mother get on a rent payment plan so that she could remain in her home?

Our St. Thomas conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society recently received a call from the mother of two young teens. The mother has Multiple Sclerosis. In March, she was severely stricken with Covid-19 and had to spend two weeks in the hospital. During that time, she was unable to work. In her job, there is no such thing as "paid sick-leave". After she was released from the hospital and had recovered from Covid-19, she returned to work, only to be stricken with appendicitis. Again, she had to spend time in the hospital to have her appendix removed, and again, was unable to work until she fully recovered from her surgery. Because of her health problems and time off work, she got behind on her bills. She had never before had to ask for financial help, and she didn't know where to turn. A friend told her to call 211, an emergency resource help line. 211 referred her to the St. Vincent de Paul Society. We spoke with her about her financial need, and we spoke with her landlord. After speaking with her landlord, we agreed to make a rent payment to get her on a payment plan. She was most appreciative and expressed her sincere gratitude to the Society. We explained that the members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society are only the "middle man", and that you, our donors, are the ones who allow us to help our neighbors in need. Thank you so very much.




