

Christ is born for us! I wish each and every parishioner and your families a Merry Christmas and blessings in the new year. Thank you for your encouragement, your support, and your generosity. May God continue to watch over St. Thomas Parish and School.

St. Vincent de Paul Society Annual Report

The St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Thomas is comprised of 33 members who answer and respond to client requests and several who work in the pantry. Within that group of volunteers, we have a finance coordinator and scheduling coordinator who volunteer their time to keep this complex program running.

The calls we receive are from those in destress who cannot pay their rent, or their utility bills. They face eviction and utility disconnections. Two Vincentians work in teams on each case. Currently, due to Covid, the contacts are made by phone. We are looking forward to home visits as we did pre Covid. We continue to deliver food in emergency situations. Each call takes 1-1.5 hours and each Vincentian takes 1-2 call per week. We aren't able to help each caller because they are too far in debt or if they have called too frequently. We try to help as many people as possible.

We made 251 calls and helped 460 people. These numbers are down this past year and we believe that Federal stimulus checks and other help from the Federal and State government has reduced the number of calls.

The Coming Together to Get Ahead program is being resurrected in 2022. This program is 16 weeks in length designed to educate our clients in order to change their lives.

We try our best to help our clients and provide assistance to meet their needs. We have learned from experience that the poor will always be with us.
