

From Our Pastor

Some parishioners expressed interest in continuing to offer "homework" to further our study of the Scriptures. For each weekend, please read the assigned readings for the weekend. If you would like to explore more of the Bible, I will offer additional reading that you can consider. See the bulletin for this information.

Fr. John Twinomujuni has been in residence at St. Thomas for several weeks as he went through his training and began his work in Pastoral Care at OSF St. Francis Medical Center. In conversations with the Diocese and OSF, Fr. John will continue to live in residence at St. Thomas. I am happy to share the rectory with Fr. John. His full-time assignment will continue to be in Pastoral Care at OSF. While you may see him from time to time, he will not have any responsibilities here at the parish.

We have been raising money to replace our older windows at \$1. Thomas School. I am very happy to announce that we have raised \$320,000 which is a sign of your heroic generosity. We estimate that the cost of the windows will probably be a little over \$400,000. We will continue to invite donations for this project throughout the spring. We estimate that more efficient windows could produce annual savings of \$10,000 in heating and cooling.

In the meantime, I ask everyone in the parish to pray for the success of St. Thomas School. As we celebrated Catholic School's Week, we continue to encourage new families to choose Catholic Education at St. Thomas. Please join me in prayer for blessings on our school, for successful enrollment and for success in making the physical improvements that will serve the school for many years into the future.

Scripture Homework

For those who would like to dive more into scripture, read the readings for the Sunday and then consider the following homework for further study.

5th Sunday in ordinary time: February 6, 2022

- Read Revelation 4 and compare the description of the angels and their hymn with the today's reading from Isaiah 6.
- Read Revelation 8 and compare the burning coals to today's reading from Isaiah
 6. The coals are used in worship as the incense rises like the prayers of the holy ones, but it is also used to purify (like the lips of Isaiah) as the fiery coals are cast down to the earth.
- Read Psalm 51 and consider how Isaiah needed to be purified of his wickedness, as the psalmist prays to be purified of his sin.
- Read John 21 and compare with today's Gospel from Luke 5. The same miracle of the catch of fish has a different effect on Peter when he experiences it after the resurrection. Consider his first reaction in Luke (Leave me, Lord) from his second reaction in John (Lord, you know that I love you.)

6th Sunday in ordinary time: February 13, 2022

- Read Matthew 5:1-12 and compare the Beatitudes in Matthew with those in today's Gospel of Luke 6.
- Read Matthew 25:31-46 and compare the Beatitudes in today's Gospel of Luke 6 with the parable of the sheep and goats. See how the bad and the good, the blessings and the curses are set in parallel literary structures as opposites of one another.
