


Tuition Assistance for the 2022/2023 School Year

The application and required supporting tax documents (your 2021 tax return and W-2's) must be received online by FACTS by the application **deadline date of April 29**, **2022**. There is a \$35.00 fee required in order to complete the FACTS application.

Completion of the FACTS application by the **April 29, 2022** deadline makes you eligible to receive financial aid from the John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund through the Diocese of Peoria and the St. Thomas Parish Sponsor a Student Fund.
