

From Our Pastor

Christus Resurrexit! Vere resurrexit! Christ is risen! His is truly risen!

The seeds of penance sown during Lent can now bloom forth in the joy of Easter. I pray that our works of self-discipline have produced a real conversion of heart that is now ready to receive the good news of the Resurrection with a deeper sense of joy that strengthens our faith.

The Octave of Easter is a blessed time to celebrate the mercy we receive from Our Lord. From Good Friday to the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the novena of Divine Mercy. This novena includes the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the prayers for the nine intentions associated with this devotion. During the Octave of Easter, you are invited to join in this novena which will be prayed after the morning Mass.

On Divine Mercy Sunday, April 24, we will have devotions in the afternoon. Confessions will be available from 2 to 3 PM, with the Chaplet, Adoration, and Benediction celebrated at 3 PM. Please join us for this celebration.

A special thank you to all who made the pancake breakfast successful this year. I am grateful for the hard work that goes into this community event. Please also pray for those who completed our RCIA program and were brought into the Church at the Easter Vigil. This is a time of great joy for those who have now received for the first time the Easter Sacraments of the Church.

On a separate note, now that we have completed our civic duty to render unto Caesar... by paying taxes... this is a good time to consider a gift to Empower Illinois in order to give the gift of a Catholic education to a family in need. You can receive an Illinois tax credit of 75¢ for each dollar donated. Your Illinois tax return for this year can help you estimate what potential gift you could give to Empower Illinois. For example, a hypothetical family that paid \$3,000 in taxes to Illinois this year could make a \$4,000 donation to Empower Illinois and receive a \$3,000 tax credit to be used in 2023. In this case, this family would save on paying Illinois tax and simultaneously help send a deserving student to St. Thomas School.

It's Tax Time

Divine Mercy Sunday ~ How to Recite the Chaplet

Divine Mercy Sunday is April 24th. The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary Rosary beads of five decades.

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. Optional Opening Prayers:

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

Repeat three times:

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. Our Father

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen

4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.
Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

5. The Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

7, 8. For each of the five decades On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

9. Concluding prayer (repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional Closing Prayer

Optional Closing Prayer Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.


Tuition Assistance for the 2022/2023 School Year


