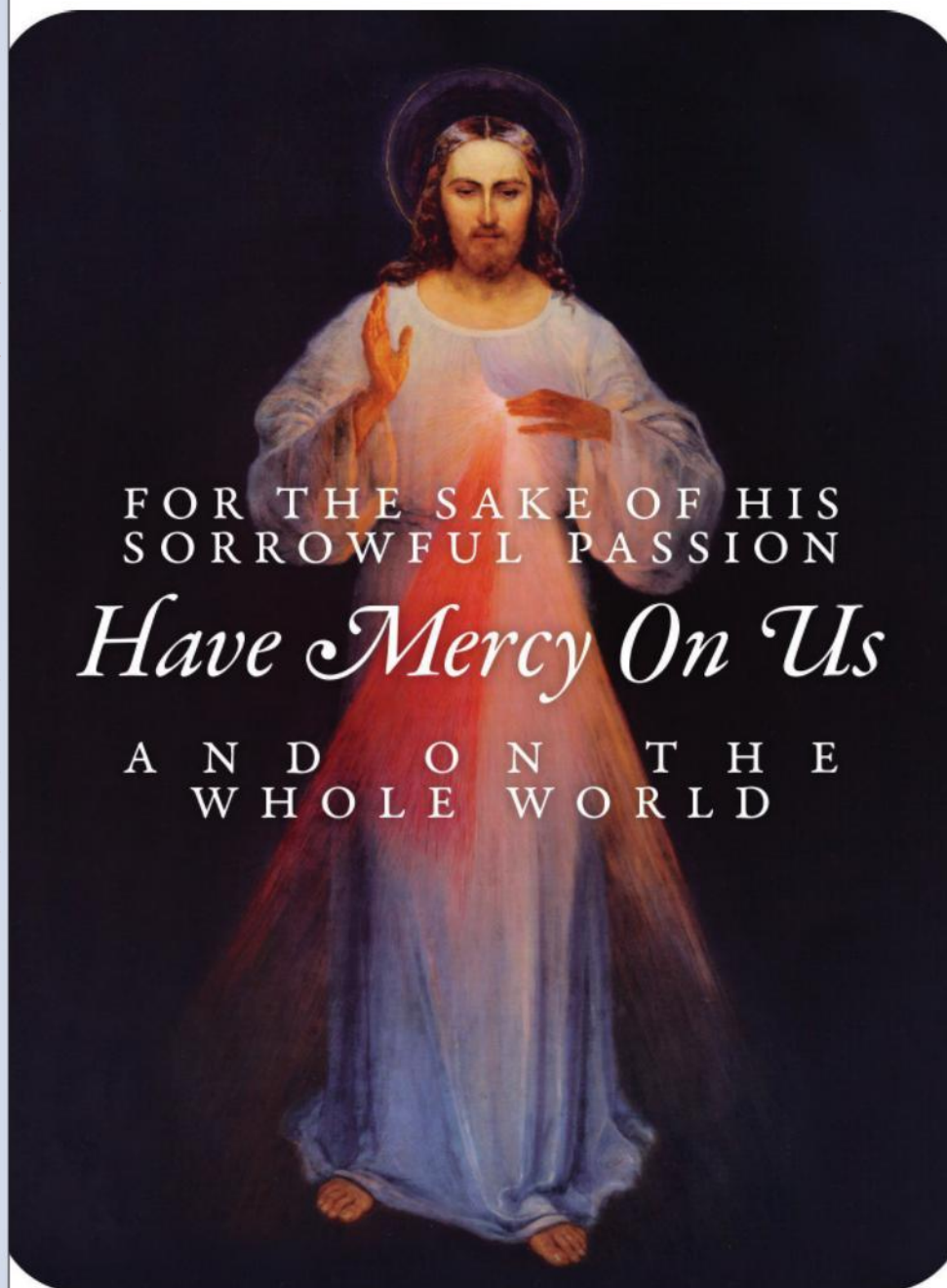

Completion of the *FACTS* application by the **April 29, 2022** deadline makes you eligible to receive financial aid from the *John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund* through the Diocese of Peoria and the *St. Thomas Parish Sponsor a Student Fund*.

Student Summer Service Hours Available

The St. Thomas Food Pantry offers an excellent opportunity for students who need service hours! Summers offer two days each week for four students to gain service hours.

On Monday and Thursday mornings, holidays excepted, the pantry distributes groceries to clients. Packing groceries, registering clients, restocking shelves, repackaging food, helping clients with food selection and assisting clients to their vehicles are activities students will perform while under adult supervision. An additional service opportunity occurs on one Thursday per month when we receive a truckload of food products from Midwest Food Bank. On these days, six students help adult volunteers unload the truck, repackage food, rotate stock and stock shelves.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus

St. Vincent De Paul fills a niche in the community support system by stepping in to help when no government agency or program is set up for that need. As a volunteer for this remarkable group, I have purchased and delivered bus tickets, helped choose and arrange for delivery of secondhand furniture, pots and pans and refrigerators, provided funds for building materials to repair a home after it had been vandalized, helped with a deposit on a new and better place to live, and paid a dental bill for a person in pain. Each situation requires contemplation, prayer, and collaborative problem solving with the person who calls us for help, and I find I meet Jesus somehow in each one of them. Rent and utility assistance are more common needs, but when we are assigned a call, we must expect that when we try to understand the circumstances of the person, compassion may require extra legwork. A wonderful friend in the group could tell tales of strapping a donated mattress on the roof of her car. Affordable mattresses in good condition are not easy to find, so they were really going the extra mile, as is often the case. This week, my assignment was a person who needed help with her rent this month because she had funeral expenses for a family member.

We take on each case with the goal of helping the person understand, maximize, and pursue the resources available to them. We encounter situations that we may find difficult to understand, and hope, thankfully, and by the Grace of God, would not anticipate finding ourselves. It is indeed good to be needed, and we need and are grateful for our parish financial support, but just as important are the boots on the ground. Please consider joining us!

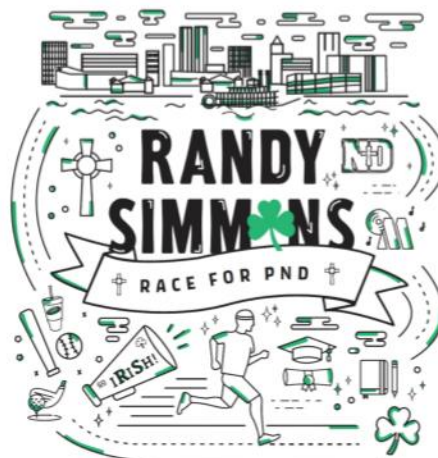
