



From Our Pastor

As the school year gets underway, we are glad to welcome our new and returning students back to St. Thomas School. For grade school students who need religious instruction, CCD will begin soon on Wednesdays to prepare our children for the sacraments and to grow in their faith. Please look ahead if you have children who need to sign up for CCD.

Even adults can have school! For those who want to learn more about the faith or consider becoming Catholic, our Rite of Christian Initiation classes will be starting in September. If you or someone you know wants to learn about becoming Catholic, please let us know or watch for the upcoming RCIA classes next month.

I reminded the students that it's not enough to just learn about God. If you appear before Jesus and he asks, "Do you know who I am?" and all you can say is, "I studied about you in class," that is not enough. To know Jesus means spending time with Him and living according to his Word. Make sure your study of Jesus is supplemented by practicing the Faith. Come to Mass every Sunday. Pray every day. Live the Gospel and reject sin. Show that your faith is not mere lip service.

As I explained to the kids, you can't say that you're a basketball player if you study the skills and attend practice. Sure, those things are important, but all the practice and study in the world doesn't mean anything if you don't show up on the court to play. So a gentle reminder to our children (and our adults): Put your faith into practice – Get in the game – Come to Mass. The Lord's day is a day of rest... but not a "day off" from the Lord.
