

I am happy to announce that Bishop Tylka has assigned Fr. Achilleus Tegamaisho as parochial vicar at St. Thomas. Fr. Achilleus is a foreign priest who has come to work in the Diocese of Peoria. I am grateful for his help with our parish. He will join Fr. John Twinomujuni who is a priest-in-residence at St. Thomas while he works full time in pastoral care at OSF St. Francis Medical Center.

Over the past months, I can testify that it is possible, even if the schedule is demanding, to cover all the pastoral demands of a large parish like St. Thomas by myself. However, in addition to my assignment as pastor, I also have responsibilities to the Tribunal and to the Diocese as Judicial Vicar regarding matters of canon law. The presence of a second priest at St. Thomas will be a welcome relief.

Next weekend, John Grillot will share information about Hope in Kids – Uganda, a non-profit organization that was founded by Fr. Julius to help build a school in Uganda. John was scheduled to present this mission appeal in June but had to reschedule because of illness. Thank you for your support of the Church in missionary territory.

These funds will help with the next stage of our church project, including carpeting, kneelers, and pews.

The seasons are changing, and September brings the start of school and all the preparations. On top of the


recent inflation challenges and the rise in Ameren bills, families face more expenses to clothe and outfit their children for school. This can create a fair amount of stress for all of us, but especially for those in our community who live on limited incomes. I assure you we have seen this in the increased number of calls and the extent of the need our callers have. Last month we came very close to running out of funds. A couple timely donations and support from some of the other parish SVdP conferences helped us continue answering the calls.

Recently I met with a lady who works as a CNA in an assisted living facility. She earns \$17/hour for 32 hours a week. She had Covid in the spring and was off work, and now has tested positive again. Of course, health care workers are required to isolate and quarantine to the full extent of the government requirements. She has fallen behind in her rent payments. She has her adult daughter and 2 pre-school children living with her, so she called for our help.

Your generosity will allow us to aid her during this time of need. Please consider the less fortunate of our community during this season. We thank you again.

And if you could help us with the food pantry, we really need shelf stable items, like canned fruits, vegetables, breakfast cereals, and spaghetti.


