

#### From Our Pastor

I am happy to welcome Fr. Achilleus this weekend as he begins his service here at St. Thomas. His arrival is opportune as I have been asked to accompany Bishop Tylka in Rome for diocesan meetings. In particular, we hope to ask for the Cause for the Beatification of Fulton Sheen to move forward once again.

I am thankful to John Grillot who presented information about Building Hope in Kids, Uganda. He has worked with Fr. Julius, who is known to many in Peoria, to support this missionary work. It is important for the Church to be mindful of the needs of the universal Church present throughout the world. Thank you for your generosity.

There is a change to the Annual Diocesan Appeal this year. Information about the appeal was mailed to your home addresses rather than distributing pledge cards in the pews. - Increase our support of the happiness, health and holiness of our priests.



# When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus

The seasons are changing, and September brings the start of school and all the preparations. On top of the

recent inflation challenges and the rise in Ameren bills, families face more expenses to clothe and outfit their children for school. This can create a fair amount of stress for all of us, but especially for those in our community who live on limited incomes. I assure you we have seen this in the increased number of calls and the extent of the need our callers have. Last month we came very close to running out of funds. A couple timely donations and support from some of the other parish SVdP conferences helped us continue answering the calls.

Recently I met with a lady who works as a CNA in an assisted living facility. She earns \$17/hour for 32 hours a week. She had Covid in the spring and was off work, and now has tested positive again. Of course, health care workers are required to isolate and quarantine to the full extent of the government requirements. She has fallen behind in her rent payments. She has her adult daughter and 2 pre-school children living with her, so she called for our help.

Your generosity will allow us to aid her during this time of need. Please consider the less fortunate of our community during this season. We thank you again.

And if you could help us with the food pantry, we really need shelf stable items, like canned fruits, vegetables, breakfast cereals, and spaghetti.


