

## **From Our Pastor**

An article recently appeared in the Wall Street Journal about education in Illinois. According to the article, only 36% of third-grade students can read at their grade level. For minorities, the numbers are even lower. The article cited statistics for different towns in our State, noting that 8% of black third-grade students in Peoria read at grade level. Some might expect that these statistics were influenced by the pandemic, but these numbers unfortunately came from pre-COVID tests. Statistics today may be even worse.

At a time when more money is being directed to public schools, the article laments the degree to which our children are being left behind. Students who can't read will not be able to do word problems in later grades and will also fall behind in math.

At St. Thomas, we have good news and many successes to report. Our students regularly take MAP tests as a means of objectively assessing their progress. Even after the pandemic, our students score above the national average by 7 points in Math, 9 points in Science, 9.5 points in Reading, and 10 points in Language Usage. Our kindergarten students are outscoring the national average by 14 points across all subjects.

Our students are also at or above the average of all Catholic schools in the Diocese of Peoria in every grade and subject. Our kindergarten students and eighth-grade students outscore the diocesan average by 6 points and 7 points respectively.

These results are a testament to the commitment of our excellent faculty as well as the loving support that our parents give to their children. They are very invested in the success and development of your children so they can be the best person that God wants them to be. The test results do not measure our expectations of our students regarding their behavior and discipline. A Catholic environment in our schools not only form our students intellectually but also spiritually and morally. If you would like to learn more about St. Thomas School, please call. 
