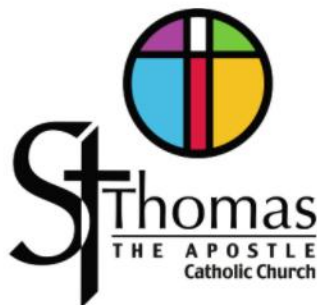

The application process for an *Empower Illinois* Scholarship for the 2023/2024 school year will begin **Wednesday, January 18, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.**

The application is a two-step process: first, reserve your place in line through the *Empower Illinois* website, www.empowerillinois.org, January 18th beginning at 7:00 p.m. After you reserve your spot, *Empower Illinois* will contact you to complete the second part of the application.

Applications are considered on the basis of the date and time this first step is completed, as well as prior receipt of an *Empower Illinois* Scholarship, so it is important to complete step one as soon as possible once the process begins. The reservation page will open at 6:30 p.m. to provide families time to complete the form before submission at 7:00 p.m.

If you would like help applying for the *Empower Illinois* Scholarship, please contact Pat at patwombacher@stthomas-school.net, or 688-3446, ext. 1341, by Monday, January 16th. We will make sure step one of your application is completed on January 18th.
