From Our Pastor

Our eighth-grade students will be confirmed by Bishop Tylka this week on Tuesday. Please remember them in your prayers. For all those who have been confirmed, let us continue to call on the Holy Spirit to guide us. Confirmation is a sacrament that we receive once, but it remains efficacious throughout our entire lives and continually challenges us to respond to the invitation of discipleship to follow Jesus Christ.

As we continue through Lent, I encourage each of us to take advantage of this privileged time of Lent to grow in our spiritual life. Lent is not a suffering to be endured but an opportunity. Lent is not about what we lose, but what we gain through grace.

Often times, we may speak about what we do during Lent (such as going to extra Masses, saying extra prayers, attending Stations, or making sacrifices). These common Lenten practices are valuable, but not primarily because we have "accomplished something" on the road to greater holiness. If we shift our mindset, we should look at our Lenten practices as instruments that bring us closer to Jesus, or that help us become more humble, or that challenge us to be lest enslaved by the passing things in the world. I encourage you to take advantage of our religious activities, not simply to have a large number of people present at an event, but because they are beneficial for our souls. May Lent be a time for you to love the Lord more, and in loving him, to love your neighbor.

I encourage you to mark your calendars for the Parish Mission we will have on Sunday evening, March 26 and Monday evening, March 27. In this mission, we will all be challenged to live our faith more courageously as a disciple called to evangelize those around us. If you know anyone who hasn't been to Mass in a while, please pass along word and encourage them to come.
