Congratulations to our eighth grade class who celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation last Tuesday. Thanks also to Bishop Tylka and our staff who helped prepare these young men and women for this sacrament.

Please note our additional Lenten devotions as we work our way through this brief season of Lent. In order to make the sacraments more available, we have an additional daily Mass and extra confessions. Daily Masses during the week are at 7 and 8 AM. Confessions are heard after all weekend Masses. On Friday evenings, we also have confessions and adoration at 6 PM and Stations of the Cross at 7 PM. If you haven't attended, these would be good resolutions to make as part of our preparation for Easter.

In particular, the Stations of the Cross are a timeless devotion especially during Lent. We hear every weekend about Our Lord's teaching, but we rarely hear about the details of his passion and crucifixion which are his supreme sacrifice of love for our redemption. Entering into the Passion and "walking" with Jesus by praying the Stations is a small way for us to appreciate this tremendous gift that Jesus has given us.

Thanks to our Men's Club, we look forward to our parish Fish Fry in a couple of weeks. Tickets are available in advance after Masses.

All Catholics in this diocese have been dispensed from abstinence from meat on Friday, March 17th in honor of St. Patrick.

## St. Patrick's Day Dispensation

For Catholics, the obligation to abstain from meat on Fridays of Lent is a significant element of the Church's observance of the penitential nature of this holy season. This year, however, Friday of the third week of Lent corresponds with Saint Patrick's Day (March 17) which, given the great number of Catholics of Irish descent in our diocese, has traditionally been an occasion for joy-filled celebrations. Having considered our past practices and the current circumstances, inasmuch as it would serve the spiritual good of the faithful, Bishop Louis Tylka has granted to the faithful of the Diocese of Peoria, as well as to any visitors or travelers who may be physically present within the territory of this diocese, a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17, 2023.

Those taking advantage of the dispensation, however, are exhorted to undertake a work of charity, an exercise of piety, or an act of comparable penance on some other occasion during the third week of Lent.

## Parish Nurse Notes

Hello to my St. Thomas Family. I met with some Parishioners for a Health & Wellness Group last month and several ideas were discussed to benefit the Parish and assist me in serving our community.

One idea was to have a regular Bulletin entry to share health tips, upcoming Health & Wellness services/programs/activities, as well as greater Peoria area opportunities concerning health and wellness. I would be happy to meet with you then or can make other arrangements. On Donut Sundays, I, or a member of the Health & Wellness Group, will also be available to check blood pressures after Masses. Please stop by and let us know how we can better serve you.
