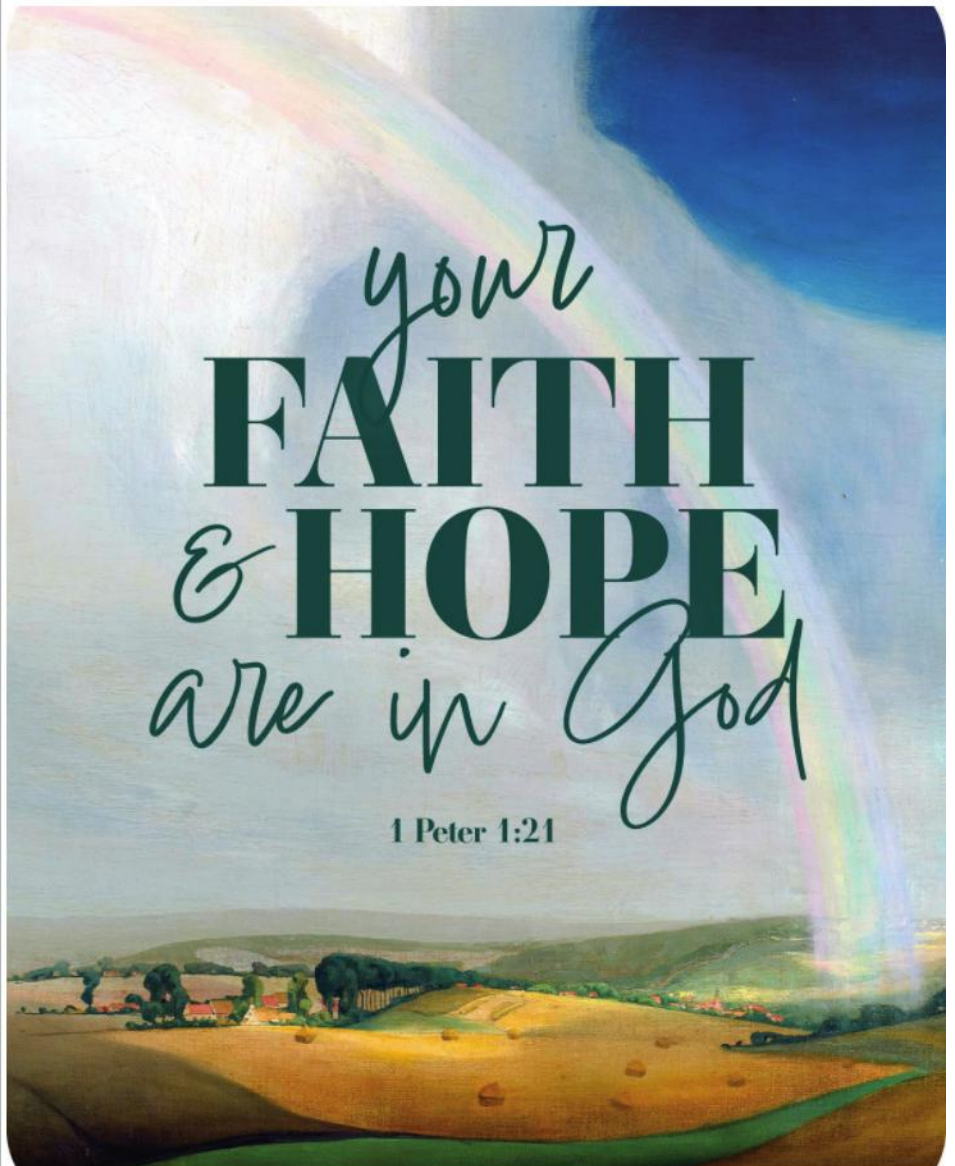

From Our Pastor

They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers (Acts 2:42).

Since our parish mission, I have asked some of our parish leaders for input regarding ways to help strengthen our parish family in the faith. Like the early Christians in the quote above, how can we be more devoted to the teachings of the Church, our parish community, the Eucharist, and to prayer?

I continue to welcome your input in the form of the open-ended sentence in the bulletin: "I would be happy if St. Thomas..." The responses I have received so far have been shared with our parish council. I encourage all of us to engage with this question so our parish may foster our spiritual and prayer life, devotion to the Mass and the Eucharist, the support of our parish family, and service in our parish and community. Please continue to reflect on this question and offer your feedback.

I plan to have a *Volunteer Fair* in the coming weeks as we have done on previous occasions. This Fair would give all our parishioners a chance to see the various activities and ministries in the parish in which you can take part.

One of those services is our funeral lunch committee, also called the Martha Group. I offer my deep thanks to Kathy Kline for her years of leadership in this mission and I thank Mary Camp and Connie Tonsor for stepping up to serve. St. Thomas offers a funeral luncheon for families following a funeral to help those grieving and their family and friends to gather after a funeral for a meal. This service is deeply appreciated by the families who have lost a loved one.

You can help by volunteering (1) to prepare a side dish for the buffet style lunch or (2) by volunteering to set up and serve the meal on the day of the funeral. When a funeral luncheon is requested, you will receive an email inviting your participation. Those who prepare a side dish can choose what you would like to bring and drop off the morning of the funeral. Those who volunteer to serve the lunch spend a couple of hours during the day helping to set up the buffet, serve drinks, set out the food, and clean up.

Are you interested in helping out? Please contact the parish office and ask to have your name or email address added to the list of volunteers. On behalf of families in need, thank you.

Ozanam Sunday



The members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul invite you to celebrate this special day with a *donut Sunday*. We will be available to share our mission with you and answer your questions.

The **last Sunday in April, April 30th**, this celebration is particular to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, commemorating the Society's founding on April 23, Ozanam's birthday, also on April 23, and Vincent's birth on April 24.

Bl. Frédéric Ozanam (1813 – 1853) a layman, husband, father, and college professor, was a widely known voice for the poor who founded the Society of St. Vincent de Paul when he was 20 years old.

Two centuries after St. Vincent de Paul's time, a young man named Frédéric Ozanam arrived in Paris to study at the Sorbonne. He soon joined a discussion group, the Conference of History, where students debated a wide variety of issues. One week, during a heated debate, Frédéric and his Catholic friends were challenged by other students who believed the Church's time had come and gone, and that the problems in society were best dealt with by modern, scientific methods.

What is the good of the Church in the world today?

A brilliant debater, Frédéric Ozanam could no doubt have offered a withering reply, but he responded instead with humility, considering whether he really was doing enough to live his faith. On April 23, 1833, Frédéric's 20th birthday, he and five other students gathered in the newspaper office of Emmanuel Bailly. With Ozanam's words, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was born: "We must do what is agreeable to God. Therefore, we must do what our Lord Jesus Christ did when preaching the gospel. Let us go to the poor!"

In 1845 the first meeting of the Society in the United States was held in St. Louis at the Old Cathedral. The national council headquarters was established there in 1957. Presently there are over 100,000 members in the U.S.

Your child can attend a Catholic School Financial Assistance Is Available

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2023-2024 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under **Catholic Education** and then under **Financial Assistance**. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2023-2024 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is **April 28, 2023**. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2023.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
