

From Our Pastor

On Trinity Sunday, All Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit! In addition to honoring the Trinity, please join us for refreshments after all Masses as we thank Fr. Achilleus as he prepares for his next assignment.



Next weekend, we will celebrate Corpus Christi. As in previous years, we will have a Eucharistic Procession following the 10 a.m. Mass.

Those who stay after Mass will be invited to follow the Blessed Sacrament as we carry the Eucharist around our campus with songs and prayers to honor Our Lord Jesus Christ. After we complete the procession, we will return to the Church and the Blessed Sacrament will remain exposed until the evening Mass.

You are welcome to come to make a visit during this time to pray before the exposed Blessed Sacrament. You are invited to sign up online to make sure someone is with the Blessed Sacrament throughout the afternoon. What should I do in front of the Blessed Sacrament? Some use this time for prayer by reciting the rosary or reading Scripture, but you can also spend this simply as time of silence to sit with the Lord. In our busy world with so many activities, time for silence is precious and one of the best ways for us to listen to God.

After soliciting feedback for an adult education, I propose a book study this summer of the autobiography of Archbishop Fulton Sheen: Treasure in Clay. I plan to start the book club with an introductory lecture on Thursday, June 22, and then divide those who are interested into smaller discussion groups. These groups can meet at the time best for each person, whether on a weekday morning or a weekday evening. Each group will have a group leader and discussion questions to guide you. The book club should last about six or seven weeks.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and no food for the day, and you say to him or her, 'Good-bye and good luck! Keep warm and well-fed,' but do not meet their bodily needs, what good is that? (James 2: 15-16)

Indeed, what good is that? What is a Church without compassionate <u>action</u>? As a relatively new member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society here at St. Thomas, I have observed my fellow Vincentians in multiple acts of compassionate action towards our neighbors in need and, of course, that action also includes prayer and words of encouragement. But Vincentians know that words are not enough. Often, my partner has gone above and beyond providing financial aid for a neighbor: visiting a neighbor in the hospital, purchasing clothing out of his/her own funds, checking on a neighbor by phone for many weeks.

On home visits, I have observed the challenges and sufferings in multiple ways: the single mom who has just lost her job; the father who can no longer work due to serious health issues; the young man working multiple low-paying jobs just to get by; the young lady who needs help with tuition for her nursing classes at ICC. And more than once I have heard a neighbor's story in a room with no furniture or maybe one chair. People need to be understood with all their problems, sufferings, and contradictions. On our visits, I see my partners with their warm hearts and helping hands, and yes, their heartfelt prayer.

And, you, our Church brothers and sisters, may not be able to join our society, but it is your generous action of giving that makes our compassionate actions possible. Prayer and understanding are essential. Yet it is your dollars that often ease desperate circumstances for our neighbors in need. Your next opportunity to contribute to our outreach is at the weekend Masses of June 3 and 4. Of course, you may consider joining us if your life situation would allow it. Please know that our St. Vincent de Paul Society is so grateful for your generosity, and you remain in our prayers!




