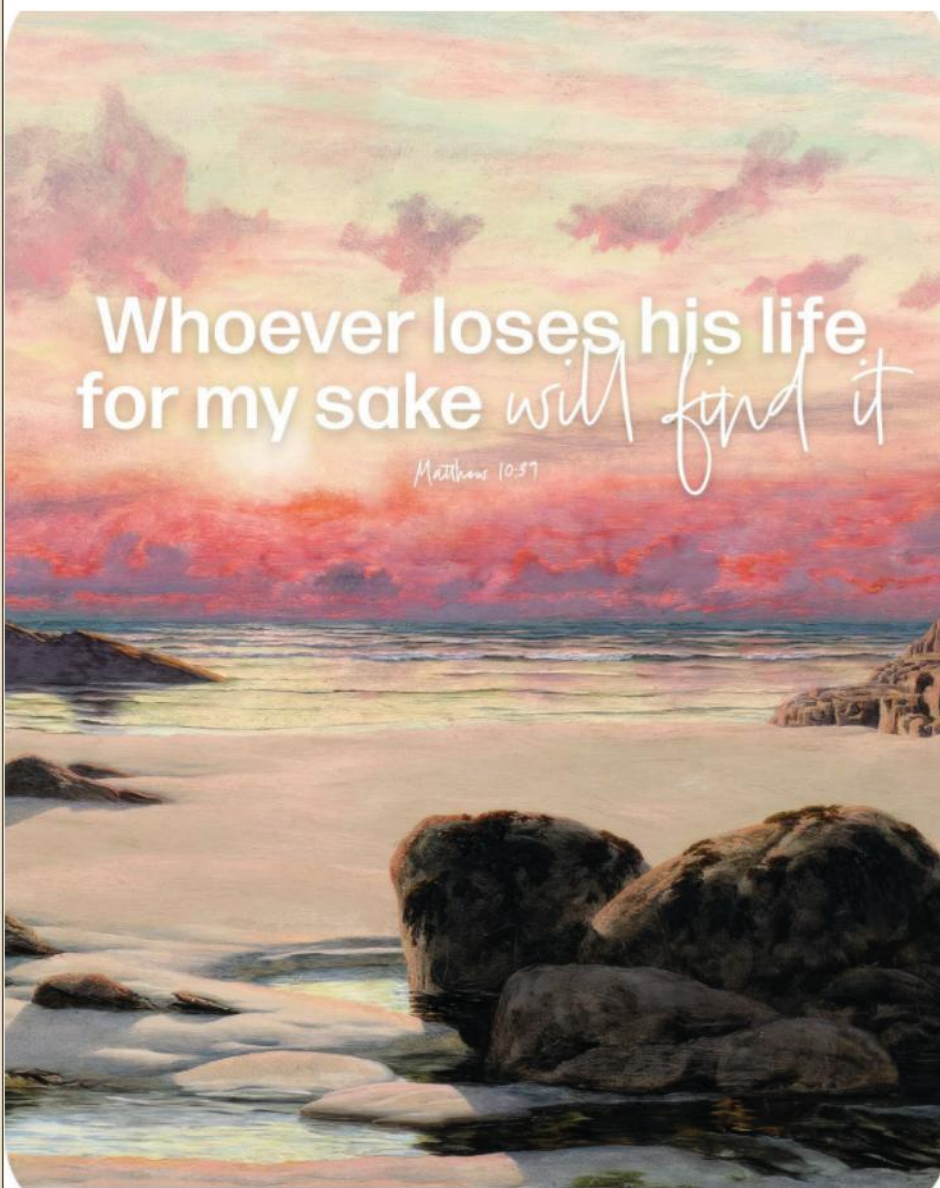

From Our Pastor

In addition to celebrating the Fourth of July, please also remember our patron, St. Thomas the Apostle, whom we honor on Monday, July 3rd. Masses on Monday will be at 7:00 and 8:00 a.m. Mass on Independence Day will be only at 9 AM.

It is good to know something about the life of our patron. I suggest taking some time to look up information about St. Thomas. You might look online, especially at sites like catholic.org, newadvent.org, newmanministry.com, christianapostles.com, and ewtn.com. These sites can offer you insight into the traditions and the importance of St. Thomas as one of the Twelve Apostles.

In the United States, we continue to focus on the Eucharist and respond to the Bishops' call for a Eucharistic Revival. Since every good work should begin with prayer, I commend to you a traditional prayer related to the Eucharist: *The Anima Christi*, meaning *Soul of Christ*.

*Soul of Christ, sanctify me.
Body of Christ, save me.
Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me.
O good Jesus, hear me.
Within your wounds, conceal me.
Do not permit me to be parted from you.
From the evil foe, protect me.
At the hour of my death, call me.
And bid me come to you,
to praise you with all your saints
for ever and ever. Amen.*

Notice how we call upon physical parts of Jesus' life (the body, blood, water, soul, passion, and wounds of Christ) to ask for spiritual gifts (sanctification, salvation, washing, strengthening). I share this prayer as a beautiful way to call about Jesus, especially after we have received Him in Communion.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On August 14, 2021, a powerful earthquake measuring 7.2 on the Richter scale struck within 100 miles of the Haitian capitol of Port-au-Prince. More than 2,000 people were killed, 12,000 injured, and 300 were missing. Then widespread damage to houses and other structures was worsened by a tropical storm that hit the island shortly afterward. In responding to the urgent needs of the victims of these disasters, Pope Francis donated €200,000 through the Vatican's Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development to support immediate emergency relief efforts in the most affected dioceses in Haiti.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



While writing this Vincentian monthly bulletin message to our St. Thomas Parish Family I am reminded of a verse from: Matthew 25: 37-40

Then the righteous will answer him saying, "Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? And when did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?" And the King will answer them, "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me."

When we see the world and all its problems today many contemplate, "How can I really make a difference?" You can and it starts here within our Parish Community. Over the course of just a few months your St. Thomas SVDP team has encountered an unprecedented amount of need from our call center and food pantry. The situation is serious and unfortunately I believe not trending in a positive direction. All of us, regardless of our personal state of affairs, is financially and spiritually much better off than our brethren requesting a helping hand. Sometimes, that can be a hard notion to swallow, but deep down in our hearts where Christ comes to say *hello*, we know it's the truth. Our Federal, State, County, & Local governments are offering assistance, but we as Christians have to pick up the deficit. The need is real. The reward is great!

This is not a plea for one time assistance, but rather an ongoing pledge. Most of our neighbors asking for assistance are looking for a hand up, not a hand out. Many circumstances, some in their control and many not, have put them at a crossroads in life. We have all been there, in some shape or form, during our journey through life. We were given that hands up assistance. Christ taught us to not judge, lest we be judged. If your intention and heart are true to His teachings then we will all be better and wiser.

Christ said *Give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar, and to God what belongs to God*. We are all asked to give a lot in today's world. Taxes, expenses, tuition, food, and shelter for our families, etc. Where do we draw the line? Only individually or collectively in a family setting do we know the answer. The answer is found in our hearts and conscience. When you pray ask Him for that assistance. He will answer. He just wants you to ask!

In summary, give what you can each month and for as long as you can. That can be in the form of monetary funds, food, clothing, personal hygiene items, etc... We have neighbors who need a good bed (mattress, box springs, frame—which is in good used shape) to sleep on. If you have extra food please see that it finds its way to our food pantry. There are many options. If you have the assistance we promise to get that assistance to the proper avenue.

From all of us at SVDP St. Thomas, including the neighbors we serve, our deepest appreciation for what you and yours have done in the past and going forward. Those in need we serve are most grateful for the help you generously give to them and they constantly ask us to please say thanks. As Christians, we cannot cut ourselves off from the affairs of the world, but we should never compromise our beliefs and values. Our decisions and loyalties must be decided by what furthers the *common good*, the basis for our Christian faith.
