

From Our Pastor

Our study continues of Treasure in Clay, the autobiography of Archbishop Fulton Sheen. Those who have signed up as part of our book club have received an invitation to a Mass at the Cathedral and a visit to the Sheen Museum on Friday, August 11. If you haven't signed up, but are still interested in reading Treasure in Clay and participating in this pilgrimage, please contact the parish office.

Fulton Sheen was known for spending time before the Blessed Sacrament in prayer every day. The Church in the United States has talked a lot about a Eucharistic revival and fostering devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. We can talk about our faith in the Eucharist to other Catholics and non-Catholics, but I wonder if prayer isn't really the best way for us to grow devotion to the Eucharist.

This Thursday at 7 PM is our monthly Holy Hour. Especially if you haven't attended before, please join us for this time in quiet prayer before the exposed Blessed Sacrament. Spend this time with Jesus and let us be reminded of the love of the Sacred Heart of Christ for us.

Many of our parishioners have read in the Catholic Post about Deacon John Nelson and the request for a kidney transplant. Organ transplant donations can be a remarkable sign of charity and I join in this prayer for those affected by kidney disease and other illnesses.

Another way of saving lives can also be through blood donations. During the pandemic, I discovered that I tested positive for the covid antibodies and that I could donate plasma that could treat infected patients. While most people may be familiar with whole blood donations, I have continued since 2020 to donate platelets and/or plasma. Platelets are especially needed by patients battling cancer.
