

From Our Pastor

As we get closer to a new school year, it is time to begin our OCIA catechism classes for those who are interested in learning more about the Catholic Church. OCIA is the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. In the past, we have met on Wednesday evenings beginning after Labor Day and have continued up to the Easter Vigil. During these classes, we have walked through all the important parts of the Catechism centered on the Creed, the Sacraments, the Ten Commandments, and the Our Father.

We will do the same things this year with one change. I will prepare some questions for each session based on the catechism so we can have some discussion at the start of each class. I will print the same questions in the bulletin, which you can consider a score-yourself test of your knowledge of the Catholic Faith. I hope you will follow along and see if you can score 100 throughout the year.

An important part of beginning the new OCIA class is encouraging people to attend. You may know members of your family, those in your circle of friends, or associates from your work who should consider joining the Catholic Church. Please reach out to them and encourage them to attend.

Those who are interested can contact the parish office in advance or email the parish office with their name and contact information. You can also simply attend the first session on Wednesday, September 6, at 7 PM in the Parish Hall.

As part of our ongoing Eucharistic devotion, I also encourage you to make time for the Blessed Sacrament by coming to First Friday adoration.

This year, we will ask the students to design their own service program and to monitor their own fidelity to their commitment. We will also ask the students to choose their own spiritual goals in preparation for Confirmation, based on their own commitment to pray, attend Mass, study, and serve others. I hope this will be a positive and fruitful experience for all our students preparing to receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit.
