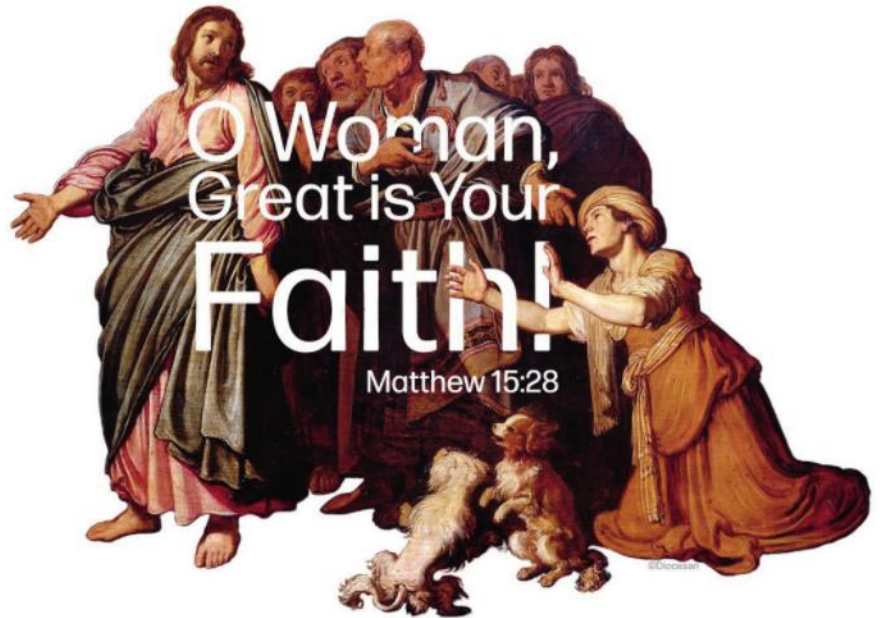

Backpack Success!

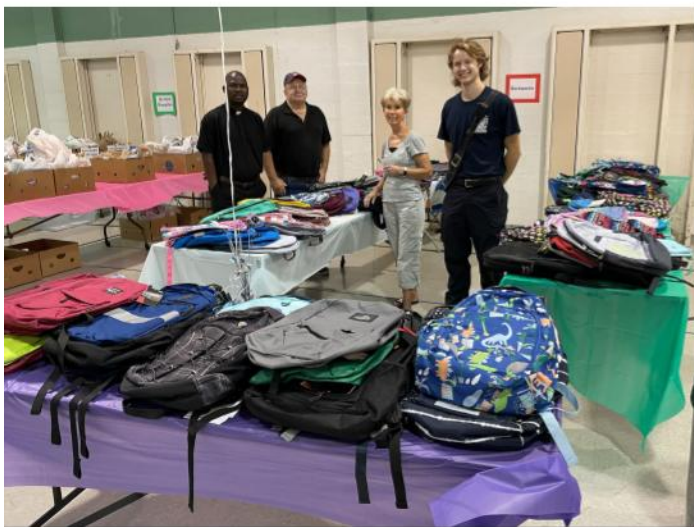

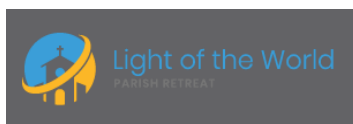
