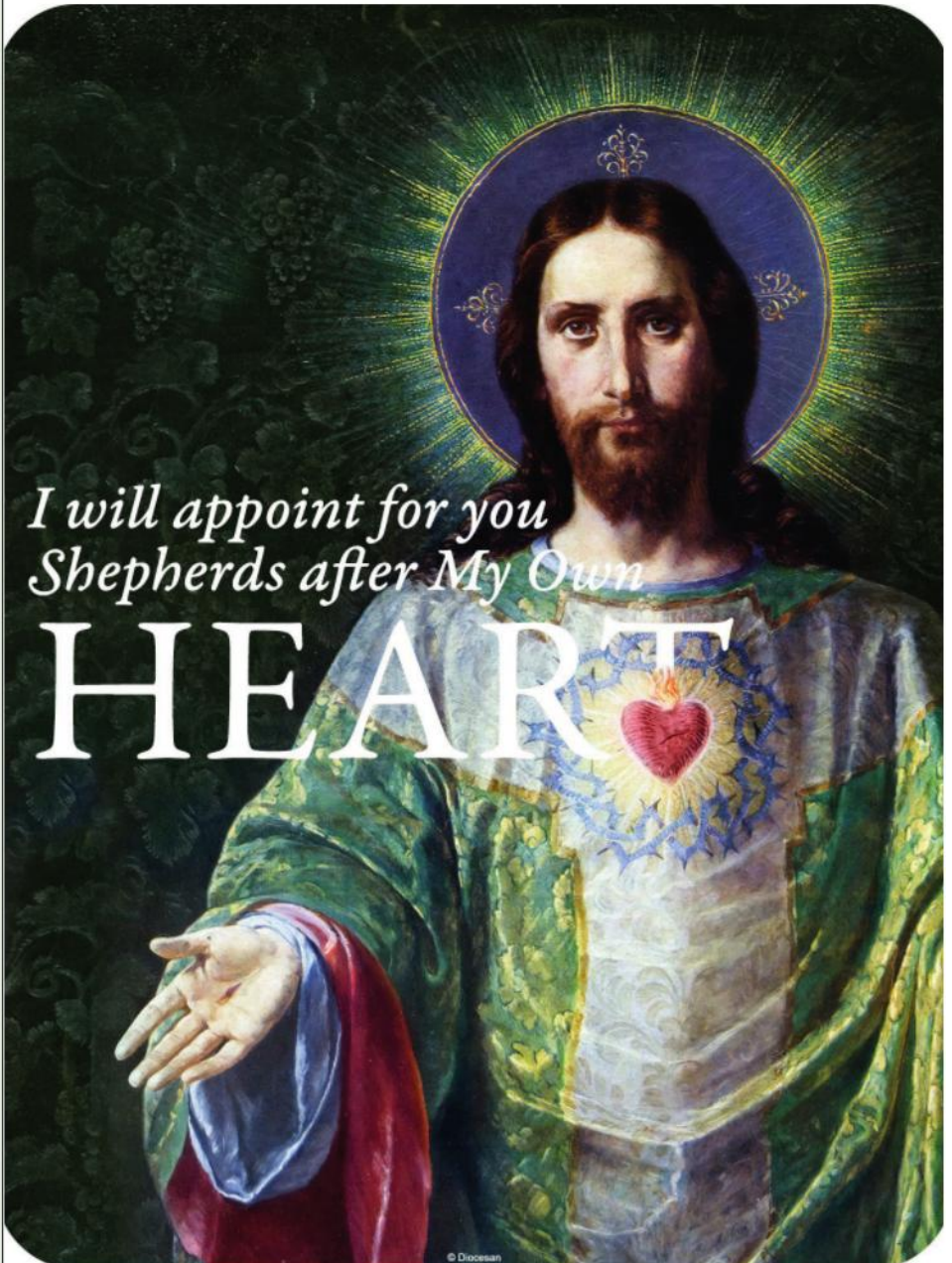

From Our Pastor

The Diocese of Peoria has been undertaking a Growing Disciples program to study our parishes and their viability. This study has progressed to the point of sharing the initial results with each parish. I would like to present these findings to the parish on Sunday, October 1, at 11:30 a.m. in the parish hall. This is a Donut Sunday, so we will be able to offer refreshments at 11:00 a.m. after Mass and then make the presentation a half-hour later.

The study will examine which parishes in our region may need to merge in order to create a sustainable model. While this proposal may most affect smaller parishes, each of our parishes will be challenged to work together more cooperatively. I encourage you to mark your calendar for next weekend and plan to attend this presentation in the parish hall.

Last weekend information was shared about the Light of the World Retreat. This retreat will run from Friday evening, through the day on Saturday, Sunday, and then to Monday evening. I encourage everyone to consider taking time out of your schedule to attend this retreat. There is no cost, as the expenses have been underwritten by a grant. If you are interested, please see the forms in the narthex or call the parish office. Please mark your calendars for October 20-23.

Thank you to those who have already made a pledge to the *Annual Diocesan Appeal*. We exceeded our goal by \$10,000 last year which came back to us as a rebate. We are well on our way this year. Please return your pledge card to the parish or the Diocese, or visit the Diocesan Website and look for ADA.

This week, our sanctuary committee was able to look at a sample pew as we look forward to the replacement of carpet, pews, and kneelers. While it will take some time to manufacture the new pews, we can already sense the improvement that this will be for our parish. Your patience will be generously rewarded!

Finally, please mark your calendars for our Progressive Dinner which will take place this year on Saturday, January 20 (the weekend after Martin Luther King, Jr.).

Empower Illinois (Invest in Kids) needs our help

The Invest in Kids Program, which has provided scholarships for many of our St. Thomas students', is due to be eliminated if the State Legislature does not add it back into the budget during the upcoming Fall Veto Session.

Through Empower Illinois, the Invest in Kids program has enabled many students throughout the State of Illinois to attend a private school instead of their local public school. Without this support many of these students would have to attend their local public school which is often less than ideal for the students and their families.

Empower Illinois is working very hard to convince our State Legislators of the importance of this program for Illinois students. As part of these efforts St. Thomas School will be given yard signs to hand out to our families in an effort to bring this program to the attention of our local community and our local legislators.

We would ask all of our families to pick up a yard sign and put it in your yard. Peoria is considered a priority district in this effort so the more signs and support we can show the better our chances of convincing our local legislators to support the Invest in Kids Program. Pick up yard signs from our School.

Even if you or your family is not directly affected by this program we would ask that you still show your support with a yard sign. This program is so essential to many of our students and families.

Knights of Columbus Tootsie Roll Sale

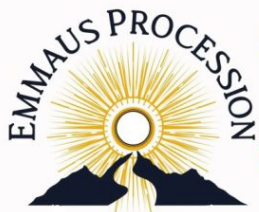

We are currently in need of two more coordinators to take turns with several others monitoring emails from the Helpline. Each coordinator serves about 4 days per month. On those days, they check their email every hour or so for 4-6 hours and are responsible for forwarding the caller info to the next team in line. They also send a summary email of the day's activity to the entire group. The schedule is flexible and can be changed to suit the coordinators.
